1 THIRD AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 29347

3 THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 29347 is made and
4 entered, in duplicate, as of August 22, 2008 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a
5 minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on
6 April 19, 2005, by and between JOINT EFFORTS, INC., a California nonprofit corporation
7 ("Organization"), with offices located at 505 South Pacific Avenue, Suite 205, San Pedro,
8 California 90731, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

9 WHEREAS, the City has received monies from Los Angeles County
10 ("County") for City's Family Preservation Program (the "Prime Contract"); and

11 WHEREAS, the City is required to involve community organizations in these
12 services and has selected Organization as a subcontractor under the Prime Contract
13 because Organization provides services required by the Prime Contract; and

14 WHEREAS, Organization agrees to perform said services, to provide City
15 with the information and supporting documentation required herein, and to comply with
16 the Prime Contract; and

17 WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Subcontract and to
18 amend it in certain respects;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions
20 contained in the Subcontract and this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

21 1. Section 2 of Subcontract No. 29347 is amended in its entirety to read
22 as follows:

23 "2. The term of this Subcontract shall commence at midnight on August 1,
24 2005, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2006. The first extended term shall
25 commence at midnight on July 1, 2006, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 30,
26 2007. The second extended term shall commence at midnight on July 1, 2007, and shall
27 terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2008. The third extended term shall commence at
28 midnight on July 1, 2008, and, unless sooner terminated as provided herein, shall

1 terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2009.

2 A. Total disbursements made to the Organization under this Subcontract
3 by City shall not exceed \$350,000.00, per contract year, provided, however, that if City
4 receives additional funds under the Prime Contract, then this Subcontract may be
5 amended to increase City's disbursements to organization. City shall disburse the funds
6 payable hereunder in due course of payments following receipt from Organization of
7 monthly billing statements in a form approved by City for the preceding month, and
8 conditioned on the City's receipt of the monthly progress report from Organization.

9 B. The City shall have no obligation to pay Organization until and unless
10 City receives monthly progress reports that summarizes Organization's performance
11 under this Subcontract during the immediately preceding month, and that describes
12 Organization's progress in providing the services stated in Exhibit "A", Exhibit "A-1",
13 Exhibit "A-2" and Exhibit "A-3".

14 C. City's obligation to pay Organization arises only after receipt of funds
15 from the County under the Prime Contract.

16 D. Organization shall submit correct and final invoices on a monthly basis.
17 Organization shall prepare and submit monthly invoices within fifteen (15) calendar days
18 after the end of the month in which services were provided. Attached to each invoice
19 shall be documentation to support the invoiced amounts. Failure to submit a completed
20 invoice with proper back-up documentation may result in late payment of the invoice.
21 The City reserves the right to refuse payment of correct and final invoices received sixty
22 (60) days after the services were provided."

23 2. Except as expressly amended in this Third Amendment, all terms
24 and conditions in Subcontract No. 29347 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in
25 full force and effect.

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





DEFINITION OF SERVICES

FAMILY PRESERVATION BASE RATE AND SUPPLEMENTAL SERVICES

Family Preservation Base Rate Services include In-Home Outreach Counseling visits, clinical direction, and the Multidisciplinary Case Planning Committee (MCPC). Family Preservation Supplemental Services include Child Focused Activities, Child Follow-up Visits, Counseling Services, Drug Testing, Emergency Housing, Parenting Training Services/Fatherhood Program, Substance Abuse Assessment and Treatment, Substitute Adult Role Model Services (SARM), Teaching and Demonstrating Homemaker Services (T&D), and Transportation Services. Subcontractor will provide all services in compliance with requirements in the Prime Contract and the Family Preservation Program Statement of Work (Exhibit A-2 of the Prime Contract). Subcontractor will be responsible for all related administrative functions, including but not limited to: all required case documentation and reporting, Family Preservation Archive data collection and data entry, staff training and supervision, Auxiliary Fund requests, and quality assurance activities.
