## RESOLUTION NO. RES-15-0052

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE COMMERCIAL TRASH CONTAINERS THROUGH THE BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF SANTA MONICA AND CONSOLIDATED FABRICATORS CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase commercial trash containers ("Containers"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Monica has a Blanket Purchase Order for the purchase of these Containers, BPO No. 23077 ("Santa Monica BPO"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Santa Monica BPO will facilitate acquisition of these Containers as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Santa Monica BPO considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with Consolidated Fabricators Corporation to purchase commercial trash

containers of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the City of Santa Monica pursuant to the Santa Monica BPO except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Consolidated Fabricators Corporation, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Santa Monica in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000) including tax and shipping, for a period of one (1) year, with the option of renewing for one (1) additional year, extending until the warranty on the commercial trash containers expires.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption Section 3. by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
