3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GEOTAB
6 USA, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF GLOBAL
7 POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS) TRACKING SOFTWARE,
8 HARDWARE AND INSTALLATION SERVICES, THROUGH
9 THEIR AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
10 DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR A STARTUP
11 AMOUNT OF \$170,762 PLUS A TEN PERCENT
12 CONTINGENCY OF \$17,076 FOR YEAR ONE, AND
13 AUTHORIZE AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$170,620 FOR
14 MONITORING SERVICE FOR YEAR TWO, WITH THE
15 OPTION TO RENEW FOR SEVEN ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR
16 PERIODS AT AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$170,620
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18 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
19 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
20 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
21 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

22 WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase Geotab telematics and GPS
23 tracking hardware and software with installation and monitoring services; and

24 WHEREAS, the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL
25 SERVICES has an Agreement with GEOTAB USA, INC. for the purchase, installation,
26 and monitoring of the Geotab telematics and GPS tracking hardware and software,
27 Agreement No. 1-19-58-69 ("DGS Agreement"); and

28 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the DGS Agreement will facilitate the

1 City's ability to purchase Geotab telematics and GPS tracking hardware and software
2 with installation and monitoring services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to
3 the City; and

4 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
5 participate in the DGS Agreement considerably more funds would be required;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
7 follows:

8 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
9 herein by this reference.

10 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
11 an agreement with GEOTAB USA, INC. to purchase Geotab telematics and GPS tracking
12 hardware and software with installation and monitoring services, of the same type and
13 kind identified in the DGS Agreement except as modified by mutual agreement of the City
14 and GEOTAB USA, INC., and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and
15 conditions afforded to the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL
16 SERVICES for a startup amount of \$170,762 plus a ten percent contingency of \$17,076
17 for a total amount not to exceed \$187,838 in year one, and an annual amount of
18 \$170,620 for monitoring service for year two, with the option to renew for seven additional
19 one-year periods at an annual amount of \$170,620, at the discretion of the City Manager.

20 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
21 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
