**2.** 23-020BH Recommendation to receive and file a report from the Director of Health and Human Services.

**3.** 23-021BH Recommendation to receive and file a report from the City Health Officer on Communicable Disease Control activities.

Dr. Anissa Davis, City Health Officer, provided the following information to the Board:

- The COVID-19 Emergency has officially ended on all fronts as of May 11, 2023.
- Long Beach still has a health order in place requiring the vaccination of healthcare workers, which will be re-evaluated before September 30, 2023.
- Discussion will be forthcoming at the federal level to discuss the probability of having an annual booster, similar to the flu.
- Surveillance will focus primarily on hospitalizations and deaths moving forward.

• Full COVID-19 vaccination can now be obtained with one bivalent immunization, instead of the two immunizations previously needed.

### **REGULAR AGENDA**

**4.** 23-023BH Recommendation to receive and file a presentation on Developing a Robust Mental Health System in Long Beach.

Dr. Jessica Schumer, Deputy Director for the Long Beach Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) provided a presentation on the City's recently completed mental health feasibility report titled "Developing a Robust Mental Health System in Long Beach", a copy of which was received and filed as part of the permanent record. The report was a directive of the City Council for the City Manager to work with the DHHS and local mental health providers to explore the feasibility of establishing a more robust infrastructure for mental health services in collaboration with the County of Los Angeles. In response to this directive, the DHHS began convening a Mental Health Advisory Group in May of 2022 comprised of providers, County representatives, educational and business partners, as well as City departments and other key partners in these efforts and hosted meetings to obtain input regarding the strengths and challenges of the mental health system, focusing on the following populations of concern: children and youth in schools, adults living with depression and anxiety, people experiencing homelessness, and those in crisis.

Following the early convenings of the Mental Health Advisory Group, the DHHS entered into an agreement with Capstone Solutions Consulting Group (in October of 2022) to conduct a provider survey, provide technical information, and make recommendations that could support an enhanced mental health system in Long Beach.
