

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO
MODIFY THE ASSESSMENTS FOR THE DOWNTOWN
PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby declares its intention to modify the
assessments imposed upon independent contractors occupying business premises in
the Downtown Parking and Business Improvement Area (the "PBIA Area"); and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this City Council to fix a time and place for a
public hearing to be held in the City Council Chambers of the City of Long Beach on
June 13, 2006 at 5:00 p.m. regarding the proposed modification of boundaries and
assessments;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
as follows:

Section 1. On June 13, 2006 at 5:00 p.m. at the City Council Chambers,
the City Council will conduct a public hearing to determine whether the assessments of
the Downtown Parking and Business Improvement Area should be modified as follows:

Sec. 2. All concerned persons are invited to attend and be heard,
and oral or written protests may be made, in accordance with the following procedures:

1 a. At the public hearing, the City Council shall hear and
2 consider all testimony, including protests. Testimony may be made orally or in writing
3 by any interested person. Any protest pertaining to the regularity or sufficiency of the
4 proceedings shall be in writing and shall clearly set forth the irregularity or defect to
5 which the objection is made.

6 b. Every written protest shall be filed with the City Clerk at or
7 before the time fixed for the public hearing. The City Council may waive any irregularity
8 in the form or content of any written protest and at the public hearing may correct minor
9 defects in the proceedings. A written protest may be withdrawn in writing at any time
10 before the conclusion of the public hearing.

11 c. Each written protest shall contain a description of the
12 business in which the person subscribing the protest is interested sufficient to identify
13 the business and, if a person subscribing is not shown on the official records of the City
14 as the owner of the business, the protest shall contain or be accompanied by written
15 evidence that the person subscribing is the owner of the business. A written protest
16 which does not comply with this section shall not be counted in determining a majority
17 protest.

18 Sec. 3. The proposed use to which the proceeds of the additional
19 annual business license tax shall not be modified.

20 Sec. 4. The City shall give notice of the public hearing called for in
21 Section 1 by causing this Resolution of Intention to be published once in a newspaper
22 of general circulation in the City not less than ten days before the public hearing and by
23 mailing of a complete copy of this Resolution by first-class mail to each business owner
24 in the PBIA Area.

25 Sec. 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
26 adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this
27 resolution.
