
DISCUSSION:


DISCUSSION:

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RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit three Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay 1) \$151,537.50 for Stipulations with Request for Award with a life pension thereafter of \$139.15 per week and 2) separate authority to pay \$3,360.00, and 3) separate authority to pay \$5,915.00 in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for **John Lee**.

DISCUSSION:

John Lee has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on May 6, 2008, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of three Stipulations with Request for award by the City and John Lee, based upon 1) a 78 percent disability rating with further provision for a life pension at the rate of \$139.15 per week after the permanent disability has been paid, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 2) an 8 percent disability rating with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 3) a 13 percent disability rating with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
