






Aerial: Long Beach Main Library & Lincoln Park Location


Overall Site Plan















Lincoln Park: Event Elements



Power Infrastructure

Large Events (Symphony)

- 400A 3 phase for lighting
- 200A 3 phase isolated ground for AV at or near stage

Small Events (Lunch Concert)

- 200A 3 phase for lighting
- 100A 3 phase isolated ground for AV at or near stage

Total audience capacity

- 2,400 loose picnic or dining seats
- 6,400 row seats
- 12,800 standing

Sizes

- 80' x 40' stage area
- Stage height ideally 48"
- Proscenium clearance 25 - 40'
- Approx. 3200 SF roofed backstage / support function

Lincoln Park: Event Layout



- 4,500 SF
- Separate area for toddlers and school children
- Fenced for security and safety
- Rubberized surface material

- Decomposed granite








Site Walls



Paving

- Poured-in-place architectural concrete
- Sawcut construction joints, isolation joint and control joints
- All paving within Right-of-Way to meet all applicable City of Long Beach standards

Lincoln Park: Benches and Bike Racks



- Continuity of pedestrian circulation, especially at street crossing
- Visual and physical barrier centered on First Street
 - no confusion to vehicular (preferred platform planter over bollards)
- Primary circulation spine framed by trees
- Event access way (20' passage)




Freestanding structure


- 3 unisex and 2 accessible stalls, and exterior sinks
- Durable material and design
- Additional plumbing, electricity, and ventilation required
- Operation independent from the library
- Ability to Close and lock at night










