

1 FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 34355

3 THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 34355 is made and
4 entered, in duplicate, as of February 21, 2017 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a
5 minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on
6 May 3, 2016, by and between THE CHILDREN'S CLINIC 'SERVING CHILDREN AND
7 THEIR FAMILIES', a California nonprofit corporation, with offices located at 701 E. 28th
8 Street, Suite 200, Long Beach, California 90806 (hereafter "Subcontractor"), and the CITY
9 OF LONG BEACH, a California municipal corporation (hereafter "Contractor" or "City").

10 WHEREAS, Contractor entered into a Letter of Agreement for the North Long
11 Beach HEAL Zone Phase 2 (hereafter "Prime Contract") with the California Community
12 Foundation (hereafter "Foundation") and Kaiser Foundation Hospitals (hereafter "KFH")
13 (collectively as the "Grantor"); and

14 WHEREAS, in order to fulfill its obligations to Grantor under the Prime
15 Contract, Contractor and Subcontractor entered into Subcontract No. 34355 (the
16 "Subcontract") whereby Subcontractor agreed to provide for community-specific strategies
17 in an effort to create a healthy North Long Beach; and

18 WHEREAS, Contractor and Subcontractor desire to attach a revised scope
19 of work and extend the term an additional one (1) year period;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and
21 conditions herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

22 1. Section 3 of the Subcontract is hereby amended to read as follows

23 "3. TERM OF SUBCONTRACT. The term of this Subcontract shall
24 commence on April 1, 2016 and shall expire on March 31, 2018, unless terminated earlier
25 pursuant to any of the conditions for termination in the Prime Contract. The parties have
26 the option to extend the term an additional one year period."

27 2. The Scope of Work in Exhibit "B" to the Subcontract is hereby
28 amended in accordance with Exhibit "B-1", attached hereto and incorporated by this

Section 1.0 – Subcontractor Objectives:

1. Identify Healthy Lifestyle patients. Healthy Lifestyle patients are defined as patients who are at least 18 years old, reside in North Long Beach, and are overweight or obese.
2. Conduct initial and follow-up assessments of Healthy Lifestyle patients utilizing the assessment tool and resource guide developed in year 1. Refer Healthy Lifestyle patients to appropriate resources based on assessments.
3. Provide a biweekly healthy lifestyle education class (or similar) over a six month period that targets Healthy Lifestyle patients.
4. Administer a pre and post behavior change survey to Healthy Lifestyle patients who are participating in TCC's healthy lifestyle education class.
5. Provide healthy lifestyle information and resources at a minimum of 2 community events in the HEAL Zone.
6. Enroll patients in Cal Fresh at the Hamilton Clinic and at other strategic locations throughout the HEAL Zone including large events and schools.
7. Share HEAL Zone project-specific data with DHHS and Kaiser Permanente upon request. Data requested to include, but not limited to: Healthy Lifestyle patient data (de-identified and in aggregate), such as number of Healthy Lifestyle patients, number of Healthy Lifestyle patient assessments conducted, number of referrals made, number of patients participating in Healthy Lifestyle Education class, and measured behavior change from pre- and post-surveys; and Cal Fresh Enrollment data, such as number of patients enrolled by TCC staff at Hamilton Clinic and HEAL Zone locations.
8. Attend and engage in Coalition for a Healthy North Long Beach meetings and attend HEAL Convenings.
9. Participate in monthly check-in calls with DHHS staff to provide update on scope of work progress.
