A Conditional Use Permit was approved by the Planning Commission on June 17, 2010. Accordingly, City Council action is required at the September 7, 2010 City Council meeting.



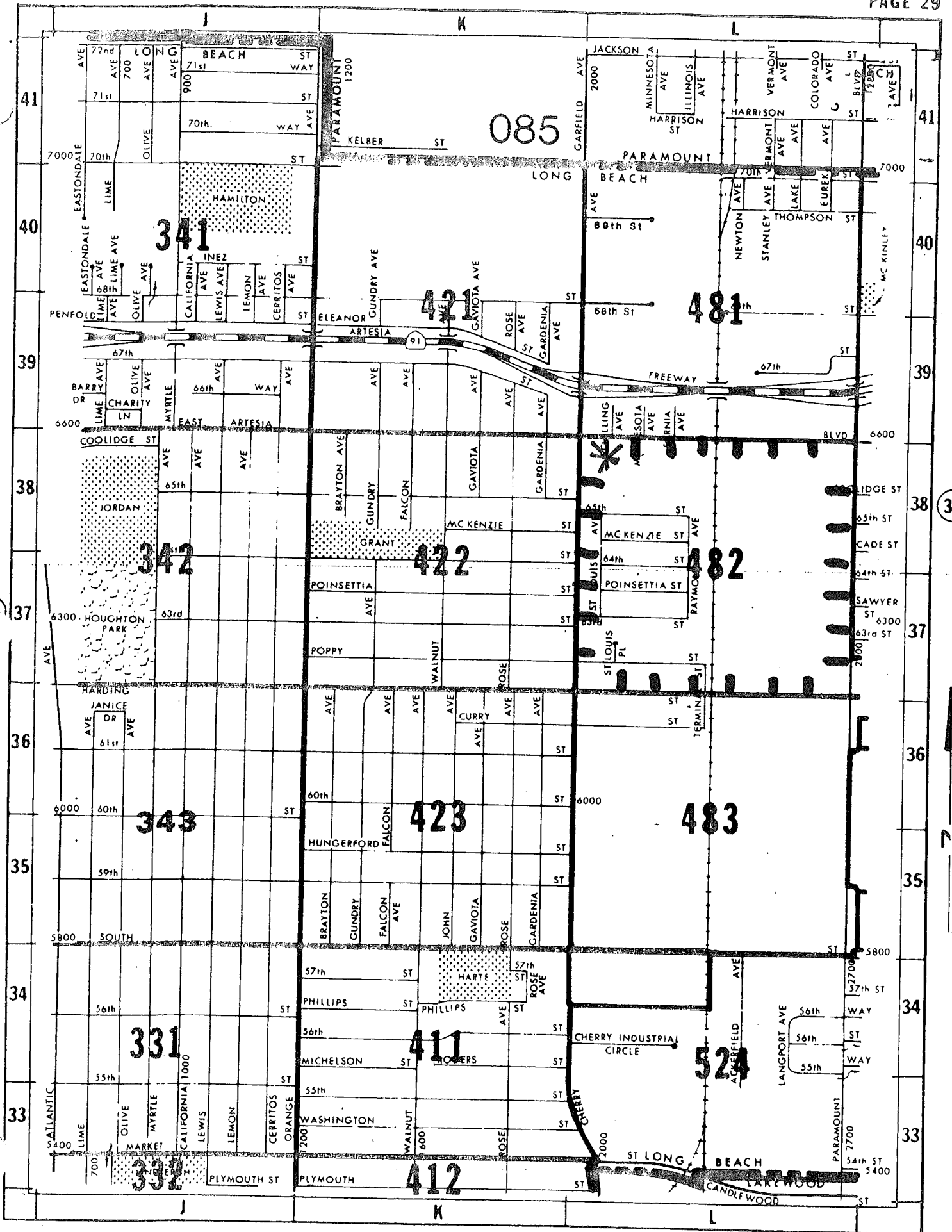

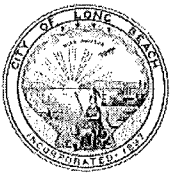
