3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE TEMPORARY  
5 WAIVER OF ALCOHOL RESTRICTION FOR EL DORADO  
6 REGIONAL PARK

8 WHEREAS, on October 22, 2010, through October 31, 2010, O  
9 Entertainment will be hosting an Oktoberfest event in Area 111 at El Dorado Regional  
10 Park; and

11 WHEREAS, in addition to being a source of new revenue for the City, the  
12 event will help evaluate the effectiveness of a one (1) year pilot program being developed  
13 by the Parks, Recreation and Marine Department that would allow alcohol consumption in  
14 certain public parks on a limited basis; and

15 WHEREAS, the event's organizers are requesting a temporary alcohol  
16 permit for the Oktoberfest event. The temporary permit would be utilized for a no-host  
17 bar, for which the identification and age of guests will be checked, and wristbands will be  
18 issued. The area of the event will be restricted in order to ensure further safety; and

19 WHEREAS, the City currently has policies that prohibit the use of alcohol at  
20 City parks and special events; and

21 WHEREAS, Section 9.22.050 of the Long Beach Municipal Code authorizes  
22 City Council licensing of public areas for alcohol consumption by resolution; and

23 WHEREAS, in order to facilitate a successful Oktoberfest event, the Council  
24 is asked to approve a one-time waiver of the City's current alcohol restrictions in our  
25 parks;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
27 follows:

28 Section 1. Approve a temporary waiver for the restriction of alcohol at El

1 Dorado Regional Park for an Oktoberfest even scheduled for October 22, 2010 through  
2 October 31, 2010.


3 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
