FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT NO. 34423

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT NO. 34423 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of November 30, 2016, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on November 3, 2015, by and between LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ("LBUSD"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City is the fiscal agent and legal grantee for the federally-funded continuation support for the National Forum on Youth Violence Prevention ("Forum") grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach City Prosecutor is the prosecuting agency authorized under State law and City Charter to file and pursue criminal prosecution for all misdemeanor violations of state and local law arising within the City of Long Beach, California; and

WHEREAS, LBUSD maintains access to all public schools in Long Beach and provides resources on school campuses for youth and their parents, including the All In Campaign to address truancy; and

WHEREAS, City and LBUSD entered into Memorandum of Agreement No. 34423 (the "MOA") for the purpose of addressing chronic truancy in Long Beach, along with associated risk factors and negative outcomes; and

WHEREAS, as City received additional funding to continue the work, City and LBUSD wish to extend the MOA;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the MOA as specified in Sections 5 and 6 is hereby extended for an additional period of one (1) year ending on September 30, 2017.
- 2. Section 5 is hereby amended to reflect that the City Prosecutor's Office shall receive an additional \$15,000 to its cost reimbursement budget:
