FIFTY-SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

THIS FIFTY-SEVENTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of August 6, 2019 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 88 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:

"88. LED CONVERSION - METRO DOWNTOWN LOOP.

- 88.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment for the LED conversion along the Metro downtown loop, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "III", and incorporated herein.
- 88.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the LED conversion along the Metro downtown loop, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$355,900).
- 88.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,

shall apply to the LED conversion along the Metro downtown loop."

2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
