SUBJECT:

Amendment to Section 10.24.076 of the Long Beach Municipal Code Relating to Parking of Oversized Vehicles on Both Sides of Euclid Avenue

Between Ocean Boulevard and Second Street (District 3)

DISCUSSION

The Department of Public Works received a request to prohibit the parking of oversized vehicles on Euclid Avenue between Ocean Boulevard and Second Street. An investigation by staff verified that oversized vehicles frequently park on this portion of Euclid Avenue, creating potential safety hazards due to the resulting lack of visibility at intersections and driveways of on-coming traffic on Euclid Avenue. A petition in support of the proposal was signed by 70 percent of the properties on Euclid Avenue between Ocean Boulevard and Second Street.

Staff has verified that the proposed oversized vehicle parking prohibition will not adversely impact parking conditions at the subject location. Therefore, staff has no objections to the proposed prohibition. The affected area is highlighted on the attached vicinity map.

This letter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Lisa Peskay Malmsten on August 16, 2004 and Budget Management Officer David Wodynski on August 5, 2004.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is not time critical.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost of materials and installation of the recommended "No Parking of Oversized Vehicles" signs is estimated at \$300. Sufficient funds are budgeted in the General Fund (GP) and in the Department of Public Works (PW) to support this activity.

Request the City Attorney to prepare an amendment to Section 10.24.076 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, adding a new subsection to read:
