I live directly across PCH from the Beach Club Sports Bar & Grill, and would like to express my opinion about their request for an Entertainment Without Dancing permit.

Tomorrow at 5:00, the time of the hearing, I will be at my long-standing doctor's appointment, making it impossible to attend.

Currently, the doors to the Beach Club are often left open, and the large-screen T.V.s' volume is often blaring very loudly. Children of the patrons have frequently been allowed to run wild, screaming and yelling, around the grounds of the complex for all hours of the late afternoon and into the night, causing a huge disturbance.

The club is a nuisance.

And that's WITHOUT live entertainment.

I live in one of the 48 units on the north side of the building at Stoneybrook Condos that face PCH. Over the past few months, I have had to call the police to report the nuisance generated by that establishment. I've even spoken with their property management company, and called the Beach Club asking them to PLEASE reign in their customers.

Across Channel Drive from the rear of the Beach Club's patio area, are another group of homes that will CERTAINLY be impacted by noise and disturbance from live entertainment.

I strongly urge that the permit be denied due to the negative impact the nuisance and disturbance caused by live entertainment will cause the Beach Club's neighbors.
