

RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0003

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT, AND ANY
6 AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH DOWNTOWN LONG
7 BEACH ALLIANCE, WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS,
8 FOR ENHANCED SERVICES ON 1ST STREET BETWEEN
9 PACIFIC AVENUE AND LONG BEACH BOULEVARD, AND
10 TRASH RECEPTACLES THROUGHOUT THE DOWNTOWN
11 AREA, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS

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13 WHEREAS, in 1998, the City Council established the Downtown Long
14 Beach Property and Business Improvement District ("DLBPBID"); and

15 WHEREAS, under the DLBPBID approved Management Plan, the
16 Downtown Long Beach Alliance ("DLBA") is named to carry out certain upkeep
17 operations in the downtown area; and

18 WHEREAS, since 2013, the DLBA has provided additional and enhanced
19 services in the 1st Street Transit Mall (1st Street between Pacific Avenue and Long
20 Beach Boulevard) over and above those listed in the DLBPBID Management Plan and
21 annual report and is reimbursed with Proposition A and Refuse/Recycling Funds; and

22 WHEREAS, DLBA has been providing service in the designated area for
23 the DLBPBID pursuant to the terms of the Management Plan and the additional
24 maintenance service contemplated is interconnected to the services provided and
25 expands on the upkeep operations the DLBA is already undertaking under the
26 management plan. This allows for a consistent maintenance approach of the downtown
27 area. Bidding this additional work would not be expected to result in costs savings to City
28 and would, if awarded to a different vendor, require additional staff efforts to coordinate

1 between multiple providers; and

2 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
3 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary
4 expenditure of public funds;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
6 follows:

7 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
8 herein.

9 Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all
10 documents, and any amendments thereto, with Downtown Long Beach Alliance for
11 enhanced services on 1st Street between Pacific Avenue and Long Beach Boulevard, in
12 an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Dollars
13 (\$243,400) for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 and Two
14 Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Dollars (\$252,000) for the period of January 1, 2022
15 through December 31, 2022.

16 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
17 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
