

RESOLUTION NO. RES-11-0029

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IMPLEMENTING GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION 20691 BY PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR MAYOR AND CITY COUNCILMEMBERS AND ELECTED OFFICIALS AND CITY CLERK TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CalPERS)

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the employer, and reported as special compensation; and

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving notice of its intention to commence paying and reporting the value of employer paid member contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Effective as of February 26, 2011, the governing body of the City of Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC) for the City Attorney, City Auditor, City Prosecutor, and City Clerk. This benefit shall consist of the City paying 4.2% of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting

1 the same percent value of compensation earnable, excluding special compensation
2 pursuant to Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation. The
3 employee shall pay 3.8% of the normal contribution.

4 Section 2. Effective as of February 26, 2011, the Mayor and City
5 Councilmembers shall pay 8% of the normal contributions and the City shall pay 0% of
6 the normal contributions.

7 Section 3. New City employees hired on or after February 26, 2011, who
8 are elected officials and the City Clerk shall pay 100% of the normal contributions and the
9 City shall pay 0% of the normal contributions.


10 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
11 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
