

RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0122

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CHARTER COMMUNICATIONS OPERATING, LLC DBA SPECTRUM ENTERPRISE TO PROVIDE LOCAL AND LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE, DATA COMMUNICATIONS, AND INTERNET SERVICES, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TECHNOLOGY (CALNET) IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,300,000 UNTIL THE CALNET AGREEMENT EXPIRES ON JUNE 30, 2025 WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE CALNET AGREEMENT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase local and long distance telephone, data communications, and internet services; and

WHEREAS, Charter Communications Operating, LLC dba Spectrum Enterprise has an Agreement with the State of California, Department of Technology, (Calnet), Agreement No. C4-DNCS-19-001-33 (the "Calnet Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Calnet Agreement will facilitate

1 timely acquisition of the local and long distance telephone, data communications, and  
2 internet services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

3 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than  
4 participate in the Calnet Agreement considerably more funds would be required;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
6 follows:

7 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
8 herein by this reference.

9 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter  
10 an agreement and any amendments thereto with Charter Communications Operating,  
11 LLC dba Spectrum Enterprise to provide local and long distance telephone, data  
12 communications, and internet services on the same terms and conditions afforded to the  
13 State of California, Department of Technology, Agreement No. C4-DNCS-19-001-33, in  
14 an annual amount not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars  
15 (\$1,300,000), until the Calnet Agreement expires on June 30, 2025 with the option to  
16 renew for as long as the Calnet Agreement is in effect, at the discretion of the City  
17 Manager.

18 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
19 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
