WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach and its citizens wish to honor and thank our veterans and recognize those who have been wounded or killed in the line of duty for their selfless sacrifice to our City and Country;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach desires to proclaim the City of Long Beach a "Purple Heart City".

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
