Re: Long Beach Leadership for Health and Jobs

Dear Honorable Mayor and City Council,

On behalf of the undersigned Long Beach constituents, including residents, students, teachers, and business owners, we urge you to protect the health and quality of life of your constituents by opposing the proposed Southern California International Gateway (SCIG) and Intermodal Container Transfer Facility (ICTF) railyard projects and developing a community stakeholder group to identify safer and less polluting alternatives to these proposed projects.

We have a vision for our neighborhood that does not include large polluting facilities such as railyards where we live, work, study, and play. We ask that you -as leaders and decision-makers of the city – take a stand for the health of your constituents, and set a healthy and sustainable vision where developers implement non-polluting technologies and create safe and healthy jobs for our community.

1st: Formally Oppose the SCIG and ICTF Proposed Projects through a Resolution

Our community in Long Beach is already severely overburdened with harmful, even deadly, exposure to diesel exhaust from railyards and railyard-related operations. These two projects are being proposed at a time of economic recession where cargo forecasts are nowhere near numbers of the current railyard reaching maximum capacity. Instead of creating and expanding railyards in a neighborhood that is disproportionately negatively impacted for the benefit of the rest of the country, it is time to take advantage of this window of opportunity to demand the implementation of 21st century non-polluting goods movement technology and creation of green, safe jobs that our community desperately needs and requests.

2nd: Develop a Community Stakeholder Group to Identify Safer, Non-polluting Alternatives to the SCIG and ICTF

It is crucial that the city work with members of the community to identify viable, community-supported alternatives to a project that affects so many constituents. As your constituents, we recommend that you support the alternative of maximizing *on-dock rail* with the use of *zero emission technologies* instead of allowing polluting facilities to expand in our neighborhood. The community supports this alternative not only because it is a benefit to public health, but it also enhances the local economy through long-term green jobs and development of advanced technologies.


The Port of Long Beach's Rail Master Plan also poses an excellent opportunity for the Long Beach City Council to look comprehensively at rail planning and projects, including the long-term planning of modern rail and emissions technologies, (such as Zero Emission Container Movement System) and the promotion of maximizing on-dock rail at the Ports.

Two proposed rail yard projects threaten the health, safety, and quality of life of Long Beach residents and workers. BNSF Railway is planning to construct a huge new yard, the Southern California International Gateway (SCIG). Union Pacific Railroad is planning to expand its existing yard, the Intermodal Container Transfer Facility (ICTF or UP ICTF).

There Can Be a Different Vision for Long Beach

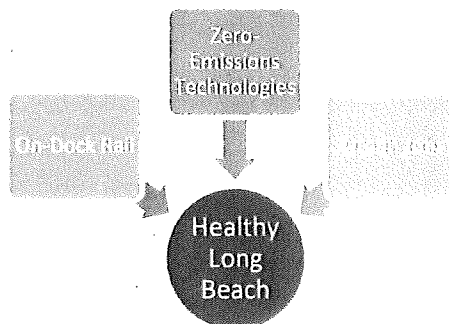
The yards are 4–5 miles from the Ports and are very close to homes and schools. Together they will handle 3 million containers a year. Current plans are for each container to arrive at the rail yard on a truck traveling from the Ports through our local communities.

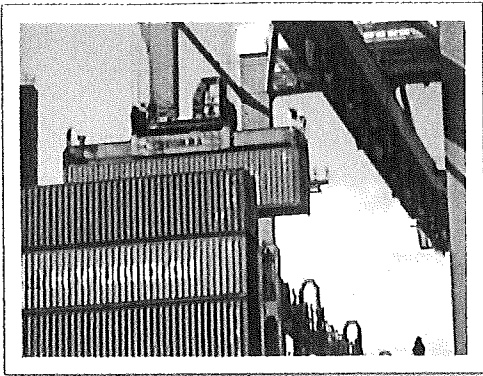
All of the containers that these yards would handle are heading to destinations more than 500 miles away from Long Beach.

The railroad companies and the Ports try to claim that these new rail yards will be “green,” but the reality is that the yards will instead add significant air pollution, noise, industrial blight, traffic congestion, and health risks to our community.

There can be a different vision for Long Beach, with strategies to allow our economy to truly grow green. These approaches could render the proposed rail yards unnecessary and minimize the negative impacts to the immediate communities surrounding the yards.

Recommendations from the Long Beach Community for Alternatives to the Proposed SCIG & ICTF Rail Yard Projects

On-Dock Rail

Identify port property that can serve as alternative locations for putting containers directly onto trains. If the Ports can keep adding new marine terminal projects, why is there no land to handle all of the containers at on-dock facilities, right at the Ports? If containers are handled right at the Ports, there would be no need for the SCIG and ICTF.

- **Start moving containers directly from ships to trains at dockside** – which is not currently done. Right now every container goes on a truck before it ever gets placed on a train, this is a totally inefficient system. An example of a more efficient system is portrayed in a video by CSX: http://www.youtube.com/user/HowTomorrowMoves#p/a/u/1/ViIjw7b_0_U Result? No need for the SCIG and ICTF.
- **Use rail yards outside of the L.A. Air Basin** –for cargo heading to Eastern destinations outside of California–utilize rail yards located outside of the L.A. Air Basin where non-polluting electric cranes can sort the containers and put them onto trains for different destinations. Result? No need for the SCIG and ICTF.

Zero-Emission Technologies

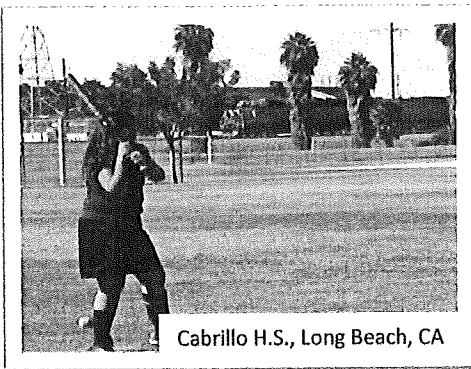
Zero-Emission Technologies are vital to the health of the community, environment, and local economy as well as an investment for a cleaner more beautiful city. Such technologies are also necessary for our region to meet federal and state clean air standards, as well as comply with the San Pedro Bay Ports' Clean Air Action Plan commitments. These technologies should be utilized to the fullest extent possible at the ports, in on-dock rail operations, and to move containers from the Ports to the existing rail yard.

- **Ground stacking for on-dock rail** – this efficient, non-polluting technology would require a skilled workforce and provide thousands of local jobs. One example of this technology is: Sky Storage Systems, Inc.'s automated container unloading rack & stack conveyor system.
- **Automated Fixed Guideway** – this system can be used to move containers within the Ports to On-Dock Rail and between the ports and the existing rail yard. Examples include the General Atomics' Electric Cargo Conveyor "ECCO" MagLev System or General Atomics' LSM Wheel Vehicle Technology on an Automated Fixed Guideway.
- **Zero emission trucks** – these trucks can move containers to On-Dock Rail and between the Ports and the existing rail yard. Examples include, Vision Motor Corp. Zero Emissions Hydrogen Gas Fuel Cell Drayage Trucks, the Tyrano Drayage Truck ZETT Terminal Tractor, Balqon Corporation's Nautilus XE3- Drayage Truck, and Nautilus XE 20 Yard Tractor.

Green Jobs

More efficient use of port property and advanced technologies will create opportunities for job creation for operations, construction and maintenance.

- **Clean technologies** are readily available to reduce green house gas (GHG) emissions. Some of the companies that have pioneered these technologies are located in California. They are contributing to the economy by providing jobs through the manufacturing and sales of these clean technology products.
- Each year Federal, state, regional and local governments make **billions of dollars** in grants available to help large and small companies implement cleaner technologies and programs. Funds are available now to invest in clean technologies at the Port of Long Beach and Los Angeles.

The Proposed Rail Yard Projects' Negative Impacts to the Long Beach Community

Rail yards, also known as intermodal facilities, are large sources of diesel emissions and other pollution emitted by locomotives, heavy duty diesel trucks, cargo handling equipment, diesel-fueled heavy equipment and generators, and fuel storage tanks.

Close proximity of the proposed rail yard projects to **sensitive receptors**, such as children, pregnant women, the elderly, and people with health problems, and near homes, schools, parks, and senior centers, can result in negative impacts such as:

- Health problems & premature death
- Poor quality of life
- Local traffic congestion
- Noise
- Light pollution
- Industrial blight
- Ground vibration
- Property value depreciation

Diesel Pollution

Long Beach is one of the most concentrated sites of freight-related diesel pollution in the country. Local communities are already overburdened with air pollution and traffic from both Ports, the I-710, 405 and Terminal Island Freeways, trucking operations, the existing UP ICTF rail yard, container storage yards and oil refineries. These **environmental justice** communities are already disproportionately exposed to the **cumulative impacts** of air pollution from all of these sources and cannot bear the burden of any additional air pollution.

Diesel exhaust is considered a Toxic Air Contaminant under California law, based on studies that show that workers' exposure to diesel exhaust is linked to cancer.

- Cancer: A Health Risk Assessment was conducted for the UP ICTF/Dolores rail yards located at the Port of Los Angeles bordering Carson, Wilmington and Long Beach. The ICTF ranked 4th highest in diesel PM emissions out of 18 major California rail yards. The study estimated that approximately 597,500 people are exposed to an increased cancer risk of 10 in a million.
- Diesel exhaust also contributes to overall particulate pollution and smog.
- We know that *proximity matters* – that is how close you live to traffic-related pollution.
- Children living near traffic have higher rates of:
 - Stunted lung growth and more school absences
 - Asthma
 - Increased emergency room visits for asthma and use more asthma medication.
- Adults living near traffic are more likely to suffer:
 - Premature mortality – cardiovascular disease (that is, they die younger from heart disease)
 - Stroke and
 - Diabetes - these are new research findings, and this issue needs more study.
- Pregnant women living near traffic are more likely to have:
 - Babies born too early
 - Low birth weight babies
 - Babies with birth defects
- Noise pollution causes:
 - Hearing loss, stress and high blood pressure in workers exposed to high levels of noise
 - Cardiovascular illness, difficulty sleeping, and anxiety.
 - Learning problems in school.

Benefits of our Recommended Alternatives:

- Shows that the City of Long Beach is looking towards a sustainable future.
- Provides public support for clean infrastructure.
- Reduces greenhouse gases and air pollution.
- Improves public health, well being, entrepreneurial and employment opportunities.
- Preserves resources and prepares for future environmental controls.
- Gets us closer to reaching attainment of national air quality standards required for federal law for the pollutants ozone and particulates matter.
- Utilizes public funding for the demonstration and application of zero-emission technologies.
- Provides an opportunity to shape the future of goods movement in Southern California since the proposed projects are on public property,
- As a community, gives us an opportunity to set a new vision for Long Beach.

Dear Honorable Mayor and City Council:

As one of the petitioners and a longtime resident of West Long Beach, I am urging you to support this petition in its entirety and oppose the proposed Southern California International Gateway (SCIG) and Intermodal Container Transfer Facility (ICTF) rail projects. Both of these projects will add to the cumulative impact and effects of poor air quality West Long Beach.

The fundamental function of government at each level; national, state, county and city is to protect the health and safety of its citizens. Air Quality directly affects both health and safety of its citizens. Each of you has taken an oath of office that includes too up hold the constitution of the United States of America. Within that document there is a part of the Fourteenth Amendment that I would like to focus on today, which states; "nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws". The Air Quality management District has already identified the air in West Long Beach as some of the worst in Southern California.

In West Long Beach the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles activity within their port complexes, traffic activity they generates on the seven ten freeway. The increase in population density in downtown Long Beach and rail activity that is generated from moving cargo in and out of the ports. Increased population density in downtown Long Beach, without insuring the infrastructure is there to reduce the health risk and impacts on the residents of West Long Beach. The goal should be to improve air quality to a level that is significant less than that at the beginning of any expansion of population density expansion in downtown Long Beach.

Mayor and City Council have approved a request for a study by Army Core of Engineers to determine what impact the removal of the break waters would have on beach's of Long Beach. If a favorable result is determine this will further increase traffic activity on the 710 Freeway contributing to poor air quality in West Long Beach.

Port of Long Beach is in the process of a multi- billion dollar expansion and is spending millions on mitigation with no direct correlation to improving air quality in West Long Beach. A mist opportunity and waste of resources.

There does not seem to be any meaningful coordination between two ports or Cities of Long Beach and Los Angeles in matters of air quality and its' impact to West Long Beach. Pollution does not stop or start at the political boundaries of the two cities.

A short time ago the Port of Long Beach released the results of a study that showed a reduction/ or proposed reduction in cancer because of the effects of pollution produced by the port. The life expectancy of the residents of West Long Beach is still being negatively impacted. I am one of those residents and my time with my family is being taken away from me without my consent. In some situations that is called robbery and can only be remedied if the number is zero.

Cancer is one of many diseases that increase elevated health risk associated with poor air quality. The most prevalent in our community is pulmonary diseases like Asthma and Juvenile Asthma. West Long Beach has the highest rate of Juvenile Asthma in the City of Long Beach.

Nothing here is meant to diminish your fine efforts to this city in any way. However at some point we all need an assessment of what we are doing and how are those effects being felt and by whom.

You are faced with what some say is a difficult task governing, but it is my believe that if you treat your residents equally and maintain that as the primary function of governing the revenues and rewards will follow. West Long Beach needs the cooperation of the entire governing body of this city to work together as a city and not as individuals. The health issues and implications of their impact on West Long Beach must be given a higher level of understanding thereby achieving a significant resolution.

The only thing this communication is requesting, that the residents of West Long Beach are given the same quality of life as the rest of this city is getting "Equal Protection". The current air quality in west long beach is unacceptable. Death and disease should not be placed on West Long Beach for the economic growth of this city. That price is too high for anyone.

Dear Honorable Mayor and City Council,

On behalf of Long Beach residents and the undersigned organizations, we urge you to protect the health and quality of life of your constituents by opposing the proposed Southern California International Gateway (SCIG) and Intermodal Container Transfer Facility (ICTF) railyard projects and developing a community stakeholder group to identify safer and less polluting alternatives to these proposed projects.

Long Beach residents have a vision for their neighborhood that does not include large polluting facilities such as railyards where we live, work, study, and play. We ask that you -as leaders and decision-makers of the city – take a stand for the health of your constituents, and set a healthy and sustainable vision where developers implement non-polluting technologies and create safe and healthy jobs for our community.

1st: Formally Oppose the SCIG and ICTF Proposed Projects through a Resolution

Communities in Long Beach are already severely overburdened with harmful, even deadly, exposure to diesel exhaust from railyards and railyard-related operations. These two projects are being proposed at a time of economic recession where cargo forecasts are nowhere near numbers of the current railyard reaching maximum capacity. Instead of creating and expanding railyards in a neighborhood that is disproportionately negatively impacted for the benefit of the rest of the country, it is time to take advantage of this window of opportunity to demand the implementation of 21st century non-polluting goods movement technology and creation of green, safe jobs that our community desperately needs and requests.

2nd: Develop a Community Stakeholder Group to Identify Safer, Non-polluting Alternatives to the SCIG and ICTF

It is crucial that the city work with members of the community to identify viable, community-supported alternatives to a project that affects so many constituents. Long Beach residents as well as various environmental health organizations continue to call for maximizing on-dock rail with the use of zero emission technologies and ask that this be an alternative promoted by the City of Long Beach. The community supports this alternative not only because it is a benefit to public health, but it also enhances the local economy through long-term green jobs and development of advanced technologies.

At present there are opportunities for you to take these two actions. On January 25, 2011 there was a Long Beach Joint Meeting of the Environmental Committee and the Tidelands and Harbor Committee that received presentations on rail infrastructure at the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles from the University of Southern California, South Coast Air Quality Management District, and Port of Long Beach. These three presentations highlighted the benefits of both zero-emission technologies and on-dock rail.





























On behalf of the undersigned Long Beach constituents, including residents, students, teachers, and business owners, we urge you to protect the health and quality of life of your constituents by opposing the proposed Southern California International Gateway (SCIG) and Intermodal Container Transfer Facility (ICTF) railyard projects and developing a community stakeholder group to identify safer and less polluting alternatives to these proposed projects.
