

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-05-0014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 2.57.020 RELATING TO THE SENIOR CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMISSION AGE REQUIREMENT

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.57.020 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

2.57.020 Members

The senior citizen advisory commission shall consist of fifteen (15) members. Members shall be selected from the elderly segment of the City's residents and shall be at least fifty (50) years of age. No paid representative of any public or private elderly service organization shall serve as a member of this Commission.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the Mayor.


