Application of Disandro Incorporated
dba La Muse East Village Cafe
for an original on-sale beer and wine
for bonafide eating place alcoholic beverage license
at 455 East Ocean Boulevard, Suite 12.

The location, on Ocean Boulevard, is in the heart of the arts and entertainment East Village district in the downtown area and has the support of the neighborhood residents. The location is in an area with an over concentration of alcohol beverage licenses and has residences located within 100 feet of the location. We are requesting the following conditions be attached to the License to address issues with the location.

- 1. The premises shall be maintained as a bona fide eating establishment and shall provide a menu containing an assortment of foods normally offered in such restaurants.
- 2. The quarterly gross sales of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the gross sales of food during the same period.
- 3. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee, not licensed by ABC for such sales.
- 4. All beverages offered for sale at the premises shall be displayed and available for convenient inspection and purchase within the premises by the general public.
- 5. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premise over which they have control.
- 6. Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 7. To prevent loitering and other criminal activities exterior payphones are prohibited.
- 8. Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent loitering of persons about the premises.
- 9. A single jukebox or stereo may be maintained on the premises; however, the music shall not be audible outside the premises.
- 10. Licensee shall not offer or permit or provide any type of live entertainment except as allowed by a valid Entertainment Permit issued by the city of Long Beach.
