RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0061

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH LOS ANGELES TRUCK CENTERS, LLC DBA VELOCITY TRUCK CENTER OF WHITTIER, CA (VELOCITY), FOR THE PURCHASE EIGHT ROTO-PAK SIDE LOADER REFUSE TRUCKS ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH SOURCEWELL (FORMERLY THE NJPA), OF STAPLES, MN, WITH CRANE CARRIER COMPANY, LLC AND SCRANTON MANUFACTURING COMPANY, INC. TO BE PROVIDED BY LOCAL DEALER VELOCITY, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,259,652, INCLUSIVE OF TAXES AND FEES

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase eight (8) Roto-Pak side loader refuse trucks, designated for the collection and transportation of organic waste; and

WHEREAS, collection and diversion of organic material was mandated in 2016 when Governor Brown signed into law California Senate Bill SB1383, effective January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, currently refuse and recycling are collected in their own separate bins, however, with the passage of SB1383, the City will now utilize a third bin to collect the organic material (yard debris and food scraps) from commercial accounts to

1 be processed separately from municipal solid waste; and

2 WHEREAS, these eight vehicles will be used to expand the current pilot
3 commercial organics collection program implemented in June 2021 to include all City
4 serviced commercial accounts; and

5 WHEREAS, equipment needs for residential collection are currently being
6 studied and a request for additional vehicles for that purpose will come at a later date;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Bureau and the Purchasing Division for the
9 Department of Financial Management researched procurement options, for side loaders
10 refuse trucks and discovered other agencies had completed an open, fair, transparent,
11 and competitive procurement process; and

12 WHEREAS, the City reviewed the Sourcewell agreement options and
13 determined that the contract with Crane Carrier and Scranton Manufacturing through their
14 local dealer, Velocity, who will assemble the trucks to meet the City's needs and
15 specifications provided the best value to the City while allowing for timely acquisition and
16 delivery; and

17 WHEREAS, there are currently no dealers or manufacturers of refuse
18 trucks with these specifications; and

19 WHEREAS, Crane Carrier and Scranton Manufacturing were selected
20 based on their competitive pricing, service level, and ability to deliver a produce that
21 meets City quality standards and the Public Works Department's implementation timeline;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the truck chassis and service bodies are similar to what's in the
24 current refuse fleet, enabling more efficient and cost-effective service; and

25 WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Bureau and Public Works Department have
26 a long history working with Velocity, who's understanding of the City's refuse fleet allows
27 for smoother operations; and

28 WHEREAS, the local dealer's reliability, expertise in building and delivering

1 heavy duty vehicles, and their responsiveness to the needs of the City make them the
2 best choice for obtaining these refuse trucks quickly; and

3 WHEREAS, Sourcewell (formerly the NJPA) has a CONTRACT for the
4 purchase of the Roto-Pak side loader refuse trucks, Contract No. 060920-CRN with
5 Crane Carrier Company, LLC and 091219-NWY with Scranton Manufacturing
6 Company/New way Trucks (collectively "Sourcewell Contracts"); and

7 WHEREAS, the City's participation in these Sourcewell Contracts will
8 facilitate the City's ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the
9 City; and

10 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
11 participate in these Sourcewell Contracts considerably more funds would be required;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
13 follows:

14 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
15 herein by this reference.

16 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
17 an agreement with Sranon Manufacturing Company/New Way Trucks and Crane Carrier
18 Company, LLC, via their local dealer, Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC dba Velocity
19 Truck Center to purchase eight (8) Roto-Pak side loader refuse trucks, of the same type
20 and kind identified in the Sourcewell Contracts except as modified by mutual agreement
21 of the City and Velocity, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and
22 conditions afforded to Sourcewell in an amount not to exceed Three Million Two Hundred
23 Fifty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars (\$3,259,652) including taxes and
24 fees.

25 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
26 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
