I'm writing in support of these recommendations from the Coalition for Clean Air, specifically: 1. Require a minimum percentage of spending to be directed toward **low-income frontline communities**, in other words: spend where residents are hardest hit.

2. Create **green space and urban forestry**. Long Beach should dramatically increase its canopy cover to help address extreme heat and to promote water capture. Vulnerable communities and neighborhoods with high AQI should be prioritized.

3. Promote zero-emissions transportation. There are not enough **electric vehicle charge points** across the city AND **parking for bicycles** is awful. No one uses sidewalk bike stands because bike theft is rampant. We need secure storage. We need more bike lanes. We need fewer cars downtown.

4. Reduce port emissions by demanding any 710 redevelopment includes a **zero-emissions dedicated lane** AND provide subsidies or market guarantees for **zero-emission trucks** to be used at the port.
