HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to receive and expend grant funding from the County of Los Angeles Real Estate Fraud Prosecution Program grant and increase appropriations in the General Grants Fund (SR 120) in the Police Department (PD) by \$100,000. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

On May 31, 2012, the Long Beach Police Department was awarded \$100,000 in grant funding from the County of Los Angeles through the Real Estate Fraud Prosecution Program (Real Estate 12) grant. The grant provides funding for detective overtime hours assigned to real estate fraud investigation/prosecution. An appropriation increase for this grant in the amount of \$100,000 is required, which will be fully offset by grant revenue.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Gary Anderson on June 5, 2012 and Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on June 12, 2012.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on July 10, 2012, to expedite use of the grant funds.

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FISCAL IMPACT

As the Real Estate 12 grant is currently unbudgeted, an appropriation increase is recommended. The expense appropriation will be fully offset by grant revenues and the grant does not require matching funds. Grant funds will be used to support overtime required to implement the Real Estate 12 program. There is no impact to the General Fund and no local job impact associated with the recommended action.

Approve recommendation.
