## THIRTIETH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

## 

THIS THIRTIETH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of August 22, 2011 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 57 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
- "57. LIGHTING AT THE INTERSECTION OF CLARK AVENUE AND GARFORD STREET.
- 57.1 <u>Scope of Work</u>. WS shall install one (1) new street light and upgrade one (1) existing light at the intersection of Clark Avenue and Garford Street, as more particularly described in the proposal, attached hereto as Exhibit "DD".
- 57.2 <u>Compensation</u>. For the services and work relating to lighting at the intersection of Clark Avenue and Garford Street, City shall pay to WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Five Hundred Eight-Five Dollars (\$5,585).
  - 57.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and

conditions relating to the Street Light System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits, shall apply to lighting at the intersection of Clark Avenue and Garford Street."

- 2. The proposals attached hereto as Exhibit "DD" shall be attached to Lighting Contract No. 24289 as Exhibit "DD" thereto.
- 3. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install a new street light and upgrade an existing light at the intersection of Clark Ave. & Garford St. A detailed description is listed below.

CLP will excavate and install a new concrete street light pole base at the northeast corner of Clark & Garford which will include the installation of anchor bolts. Once the concrete has cured, CLP will install a new 31' concrete street light pole with 6' arm and a 150 walt high pressure sodium (HPS) fixture. This street light will be serviced by an overhead feed consistent with the other street lights in the area. CLP will also upgrade the existing 70 walt HPS fixture on the southeast corner of Clark & Garford to a 150 walt HPS fixture. The cost to complete this project is Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$5,585).
