




Current Calendar

 Legacy-based calendar migrated into the CMS in 2017

- Limitations:
 - Lacks advanced functionality
 - Limited filtering options
 - Not dynamic
 - Not interactive
 - Not shareable
 - Not able to receive notifications






New Event Calendar - Benefits

- New options and features

Staff:


- Customized to meet City needs
- o Easier for staff to maintain






New Event Calendar – Simplified Homepage Access

- Homepage view replaces the "Special Events" and "Meetings and Notices" calendar
- Basic structured event details are provided up front
- Department calendars are automatically integrated into master calendar
- Navigate the calendar from the homepage or access the full calendar



New Event Calendar – Expanded Viewing Options

- Eye-catching tile view is the default for desktop
 - Three additional views available: Month, List and Map
- Tiles include basic event information and link to dedicated event pages with more details
- List view is default for mobile to ensure an optimized experience



New Event Calendar - Advanced Filtering


- Several ways to search for events and meetings:
 - o Calendar Name
 - Event Type
 - Keyword Search
 - Proximity





New Event Calendar – Feature-rich Event Pages


- Each instance produces a page with full event details including:
 - Event description
 - Contact information
 - Social media sharing options
 - Personal calendar input
 - Shareable QR code
 - RSVP option
 - Sign up to speak option





New Event Calendar - Notification


- Calendar/Event subscriptions
- Receive calendar/event notifications through text or email
 - Updates on existing events and new events
- City Council can receive notifications when an event is added in their District
