I am contacting you regarding the Preferential Parking of District 'R' on Marita Street between Fanwood Avenue and San Vicente Avenue.

We strongly oppose the recommendation for the Preferential Parking because it will cause parking congestion on the neighboring streets, i.e., the rest of Marita Street and San Vicente Avenue in particular.

We believe that the heavy parking on our streets has been due to the building of the CSULB parking structure on Palo Verde Avenue. Once this structure has been completed, the parking congestion will be alleviated.

Please re-consider the Preferential Parking on Marita Street until after the CSULB parking structure is completed and re-evaluate if the residents that originally requested the Preferential Parking are still in need.
