AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 2.03.076
RELATING TO FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR
AGENDA ITEMS AUTHORED BY A COUNCILMEMBER

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.03.076 is added to the Long Beach Municipal Code
to read as follows:

2.03.076 Fiscal impact statement for agenda items authored by a
councilmember.

Any agenda item authored and submitted by any councilmember
shall state the fiscal impacts of the requested action. The item shall contain
a fiscal impact statement prepared by such councilmember, indicating
whether approval of the requested action is anticipated to have a significant
fiscal impact, no significant fiscal impact, or no fiscal impact. For fiscal
impacts of a determinate nature, the fiscal impact statement shall include
such councilmember's estimate of increases or decreases in City
expenditures or revenues that would result if the requested action was to be
approved by the City Council.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by
the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of
Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the
Mayor.
