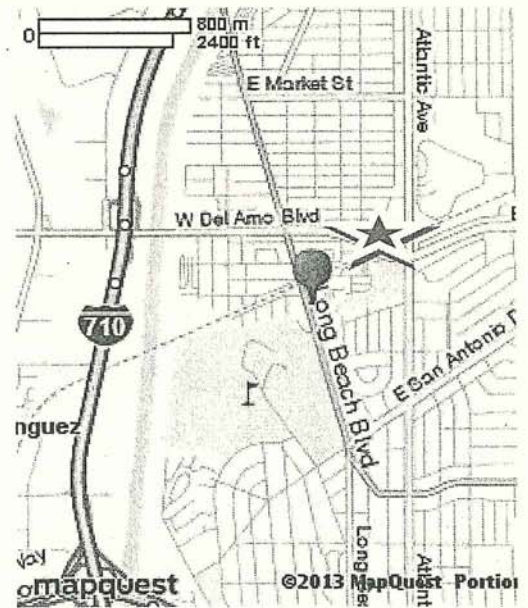
9:00 – Racing Starts

Rules and Information

1. Each Dog must have proof of Rabies Vaccination, current tags, or letter from Vet.
2. Race distances are 35 feet for toys, wheelie and senior divisions. 53 feet for mini's, standards, dogs up to 20 lbs and dogs up to 30 lbs.
3. Each Dog must be accompanied by 2 humans, one human to release Dog from start gate and one human to catch Dog at the finish line.
4. Each race continues until we have a winner AND all other competitors in the race either finish or "resign" (i.e. owner picks them up). The Dog must cross finish line completely which means all four legs.
5. Owners can have Dog's favorite TOY or TREAT to help motivate their dog.
6. All Judges' rulings regarding breed & order of finish are final.

Directions and Parking



Uptown Dog Park is located at 4600 Long Beach Blvd, in North Long Beach.

There is limited residential street parking on Long Beach Blvd. Participants are encouraged to use the two parking lots adjacent to the Police Substation on Atlantic @ Del Amo – (see star).

There are paths that lead you past the duck pond, tennis and basketball courts to the Dog Park Area. For **Drop-offs ONLY** you may enter @ Pasadena Ave, drop dogs and family off at the Elm street exit and then find parking.

Please be considerate of the neighborhood and pick up and dispose of any animal waste.
