DISCUSSION:

The Long Beach Municipal Code Section 2.50.040 prescribes the duties of the Technology and Innovation Commission to advise and make recommendations to the City Council on matters pertaining to technology and innovation within the City. The City Council hereby requests that the Technology and Innovation Commission review matters enumerated under Long Beach Municipal Code Section 2.50.040 and additionally review the City's open data policies and practices, City mobile applications and technology uses by other municipalities and government agencies. The intent of the review process is for the Commission to make recommendations to Council to ensure that the City adopts the best technology and technology related policies.

The review should be ongoing and conducted under the guidance of the City Manager or designated staff. The review process should include but is not limited to, presentations made to the Commission, reports to the Commission by city staff or other activities as deemed appropriate by the City Manager or designated staff. The recommendations of the commission shall be reported to Council as needed and as appropriate.
