#### A BOLD AND RESPONSIBLE RESPONSE

- TESTED UP TO 5,000 PEOPLE A DAY
- MORE THAN 715,000 COVID-19 TESTS ADMINISTERED TO-DATE
- HOSPITALIZATIONS DOWN 86.5% SINCE THE PEAK OF THE SURGE
- POSITIVITY RATE DOWN TO BELOW 2.6%, WAS 17.4% AT ITS PEAK, A 85.1% DECLINE

- OVER 132,000 DOSES OF VACCINE ADMINISTERED
- 68% OF ALL SENIORS IN LONG BEACH VACCINATED
- OFFERED THOUSANDS OF APPOINTMENTS TO FOOD AND GROCERY WORKERS
- COMPLETED NEARLY ALL EDUCATORS AND SCHOOL STAFF LBUSD ON TRACK TO REOPEN CAMPUSES MARCH 29
- FIRST IN THE STATE TO OPEN VACCINES TO PEOPLE W/ DISABILITIES
