A BOLD AND RESPONSIBLE RESPONSE

- TESTED UP TO 5,000 PEOPLE A DAY**
- MORE THAN 715,000 COVID-19 TESTS ADMINISTERED TO-DATE**
- HOSPITALIZATIONS DOWN 86.5% SINCE THE PEAK OF THE SURGE**
- POSITIVITY RATE DOWN TO BELOW 2.6%, WAS 17.4% AT ITS PEAK, A 85.1% DECLINE**

A NATIONAL MODEL ON VACCINATIONS

- OVER 132,000 DOSES OF VACCINE ADMINISTERED**
- 68% OF ALL SENIORS IN LONG BEACH VACCINATED**
- OFFERED THOUSANDS OF APPOINTMENTS TO FOOD AND GROCERY WORKERS**
- COMPLETED NEARLY ALL EDUCATORS AND SCHOOL STAFF – LBUSD ON TRACK TO REOPEN CAMPUSES MARCH 29**
- FIRST IN THE STATE TO OPEN VACCINES TO PEOPLE W/ DISABILITIES**
