RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to adopt minute order to grant an application from Herminia N. Estes for a widow's pension.

DISCUSSION

We are in receipt of an application from Herminia N. Estes for a widow's pension. Franklin O. Estes, who died on or about the 17th day of July, 2012, was a retired Police Sergeant in the Long Beach Police Department, having retired from active duty on October 1, 1967. Mrs. Estes has filed an application for a widow's pension under the provisions of Subsection (4) of Section 187 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach prior to its repeal.

We are of the opinion that Mrs. Estes is entitled to a widow's pension. We are transmitting herewith a Declaration and a form of minute order to be adopted by your honorable body granting Herminia O. Estes a widow's pension effective July 18, 2012.

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MINUTE ORDER

Councilmember _____ moved, second by

Attorney and the accompanying declaration be received and filed, and it appearing from
the application for a widow's pension that, Franklin O. Estes, who died on or about July
17, 2012, was a retired Police Sergeant in the Long Beach Police Department, having
retired from active duty on October 1, 1967; that Herminia N. Estes is his widow and is
entitled to be granted and to be paid during her lifetime, or until she remarries, an annual
pension equal to fifty percent (50%) of the salary attached to the rank of Police Sergeant,
to become effective July 18, 2012, and that such payments shall be made from such funds
as the City may be required to provide for that purpose.

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DECLARATION


HERMINIA N. ESTES states:

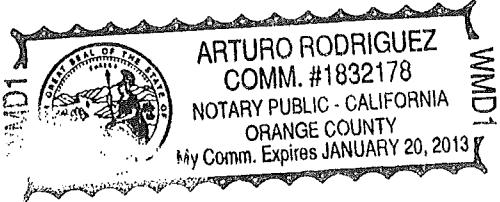
