A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA AND GOVERNMENT TECHNOLOGY SERVICES, INC.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase electronic safety equipment, including mobile data computers; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fairfax, Virginia has a contract for the purchase of this electronic safety equipment, Contract Number RQ03-605674-16A ("Fairfax Contract"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the Fairfax Contract will facilitate acquisition of this electronic safety equipment as well as provide considerable costs benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Fairfax Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated hereby by this reference.

(called GTSI Corp. in the Fairfax Contract) to purchase this electronic safety equipment of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the County of Fairfax, Virginia pursuant to the Fairfax Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City of Long Beach and Government Technology Services, Inc. and the purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the County of Fairfax, Virginia in an amount not to exceed \$2,494,877.05 plus tax, for a period extending until the warranty on the this electronic safety equipment expires.

Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
