3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH LOS
6 ANGELES TRUCK CENTERS, LLC, DBA VELOCITY
7 TRUCK CENTERS, TO PURCHASE AN AUTOCAR ACX64
8 FRONT LOADING REFUSE TRUCK, THROUGH THEIR
9 CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF GLENDALE, IN AN
10 ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$344,807,
11 INCLUDING TAX AND FEES

13 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
14 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
15 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
16 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

17 WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase an Autocar ACX64 front loading
18 refuse truck ("Refuse Truck"); and

19 WHEREAS, the Refuse Truck will replace an existing unit in the
20 Environmental Services Bureau, Refuse Division in the Public Works Department; and

21 WHEREAS, the current vehicle is five years past its useful life and the new
22 unit is necessary to ensure the continuity of operations; and

23 WHEREAS, this new unit will be the same model as the three other front
24 loader trucks currently in the fleet, enabling operators to be assigned to use any of the
25 trucks as needed; and

26 WHEREAS, failure to replace the existing unit will result in increased
27 maintenance and replacement costs and could result in increased downtime and possible
28 service interruptions; and

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1 WHEREAS, the City of Glendale has a contract with Los Angeles Truck
2 Centers, LLC, dba Velocity Truck Centers, for the purchase of the Refuse Truck,
3 Purchase Order No. 61900874 (“Glendale Contract”); and

4 WHEREAS, the City’s participation in the Glendale Contract will facilitate
5 acquisition of the Refuse Truck as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
8 participate in the Glendale Contract considerably more funds would be required;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
10 follows:

11 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
12 herein by this reference.

13 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
14 an agreement with Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC, dba Velocity Truck Centers, to
15 purchase a Refuse Truck, of the same type and kind identified in the Glendale Contract
16 except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Los Angeles Truck Centers,
17 LLC, dba Velocity Truck Centers, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same
18 terms and conditions afforded to the City of Glendale, in an amount not to exceed Three
19 Hundred Forty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seven Dollars (\$344,807), including tax
20 and fees.

21 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
22 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
