RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and deny the Permit Application for Entertainment without Dancing by Patrons for Smelly Kat, Inc., DBA Smelly Kat, 1739 E. Artesia Blvd. (District 9)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the permit application is complete and truthful; the applicant and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and that public peace, welfare and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall either be approved for a long-term or short-term entertainment permit. Otherwise, the permit application shall be denied.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, the business ownership and permit history, and the entertainment permit application.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons be denied. Based on the Vice Section's investigation, along with opposition from local residents, the Police Department is unable to find that the public peace, safety, and welfare will not be impaired if this permit is granted.
- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Long Beach Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Bar/Tavern/Lounge since April 1998.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of June 10, 2008, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on May 19, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Team Inspection \$300 and Zoning Review \$14 (Long Beach Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,000 (Police Department), Temporary Permit \$300, Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department), and Health/Noise Control \$94 (Health and Human Services Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$299.88 and Regulatory \$250 (Financial Management Department).



APPLICATION FOR ENTERTAINMENT WITHOUT DANCING AT SMELLY KAT - 1739 EAST ARTESIA BOULEVARD

The Police Department recommends **DENIAL** of this application for Entertainment <u>Without</u> Dancing for Smelly Kat, located at 1739 E. Artesia Boulevard. This recommendation is based on calls-for-service involving violence over the past two years, objections from the residents who live within 100 feet of the location, and a recommendation from the North Division Patrol Commander.

Background

Smelly Kat is a bar located on the northwest corner of Artesia Boulevard and Rose Avenue. The business is a for-profit corporation, Smelly Kat Inc., dba Smelly Kat. The president is listed as Jalinda Sharland, who also holds a Type 48 (On Sale General public premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. On January 30, 2008, Smelly Kat applied for an Entertainment Without Dancing permit, which includes live amplified music, a disc jockey, and karaoke music.

Crime Analysis

As part of the investigation, Vice Detectives examined calls for service, crime reports and arrests at the above location for a two-year period between March 29, 2005 and March 29, 2007. The report shows twenty-four (24) calls for service, four (4) incident reports, and one (1) arrest attributable to the business. Of the 24 calls-for-service, six involved guns and one incident involved shots fired inside the business. Five calls involved fights, one of which involved 20 people. Six calls were for unwelcome subjects or customers causing problems. For further details, see crystal report analysis.

Patrol Division

North Division Patrol Commander Billy Quach was contacted for an opinion regarding the issuance of this permit. He indicated there have been many fights at the location, which have included gunfire. On one occasion, officers chased a wanted suspect into the bar. The bartender and patrons interfered with officers' entry into the bar and attempted to hide the wanted suspect. A North Division Patrol Sergeant has had numerous meetings with the owner regarding problems at the bar. However, the owner has been uncooperative. Due to the problems at the bar and the unwillingness of the owner to correct the problems, Commander Quach is recommending that we deny the application for an entertainment permit at Smelly Kat.

Vice Investigations

Team Inspection

On February 14, 2008, a team inspection was conducted at the location. Vice Detectives along with representatives from the Fire Department and Health Department met with David Clapper, who is an owner/operator of Smelly Kat. During the inspection, detectives supplied Mr. Clapper with a list of conditions that would be applied to their temporary permit. Detectives mentioned some past problems with the bar, and stressed the importance of adhering to the conditions and the importance of security. Smelly Kat was subsequently issued a temporary entertainment permit on February 26, 2008.

Undercover Police Investigations

As part of the investigation, Vice Detectives went to the location in an undercover capacity on Wednesday, February 20, 2008, at approximately 2100 hours. There were a few customers inside drinking and playing pool. During this investigation, a customer made it known that non-locals are not welcome at the bar and as a result, fights sometime occur. There was not any entertainment offered on this night and there was no security personnel present.

On Saturday, February 23, 2008, at approximately 1900 hours, detectives went to the location. There were approximately seven people inside the bar drinking and listening to amplified music. There was no security personnel present.


On Friday, February 29, 2008, at approximately 2345 hours, detectives went to the location. There were approximately 20 people inside drinking, playing pool, playing darts, and listening to amplified music. There were approximately eight people loitering in the parking lot, and again, there was no security personnel present.

Resident Contacts

Vice Detectives also contacted residents within 100 feet of the establishment. There were 25 residences within this distance. Four residents were opposed to the addition of entertainment because there had been many fights, loud patrons and shootings at the bar. Three residents were not opposed to the addition of an entertainment permit. The remaining 18 residents were not home during our investigation and were left a letter requesting they contact us.

Recommendation

Based on the Vice Section's investigation and North Division's recommendation, along with the opposition from local residents, the Police Department is unable to find that the public peace, safety, and welfare of the general area will not be impaired if this permit is granted. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5.72.120(d)(4) LBMC, the Police Department recommends that a permit for Entertainment Without Dancing at this location be DENIED.



DISCUSSION

The Municipal Code requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before a license or permit is granted or denied. The hearing is proposed to be on June 10, 2008 at 5:00 p.m.

The Municipal Code also requires that the City Council make the determination that the application is complete and truthful and that the applicant, the persons interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner and that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved; if not, it shall be denied. The Commercial Services Bureau Manager will notify the applicant of the time and place of the hearing and post the premises in accordance with the Municipal Code.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The business known as Smelly Kat Inc., DBA Smelly Kat, has been providing entertainment without dancing by patrons on a temporary entertainment permit that will expire on June 26, 2008. The hearing date must be set at least two weeks prior to hearing for proper applicant and public notification.
