RE: Amendment No. Three to PA-00413 to Contract No. 33071 for providing grounds maintenance services to the City of Long Beach.

This Amendment to Contract No. 33071 is made and entered as of September 30, 2015, by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation, and **Azteca Landscape, Inc.** (Contractor)

Contract No. 33071 is amended by mutual agreement of the parties and as indicated below by a check or other mark preceding the appropriate amendment:

- 1. The term is still valid until 5/31/16.
- 2. No change to the total amount of \$6,657,534.
- 3. Prices during this period shall remain firm.
- 4. The price for certain items shall be increased as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 5. The price for certain items shall be decreased as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 6. The discount offered to the City is increased by ____ %
- 7. The items or locations identified on Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby deleted from the Contract.
- 8. The locations identified on Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby added to the Contract.
- 9. Current permits, licenses, insurance and other required information are attached as Addendum No. 1.

Except as expressly amended above, all terms and conditions in this Contract are ratified and confirmed and remain in full force and effect. Executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.

RE: Paid Sick Leave Cost

Dear Ms. Takii:

With the enactment of the mandatory Paid Sick Leave policy, our costs per man our have increased.

Per the new law, employers has a choice of and accrual method or lump sum method. We have elected to implement the Lump Sum Method due to ease of tracking. Below, I have presented an analysis showing how we calculated the additional cost per man-hour.

First: **24 hours** are placed in each employees' sick leave "bank."

Second: **2,080 hours** are the number of hours an employee works per year.

Thus, an employee earns **.0115 sick leave hours** for every hour worked.

Our average rate of pay is **\$13.09 per hour**.

Multiply the hourly rate of **\$13.09 times .0115 sick leave rate**, equals **\$.015 per hour**.

Hence, our additional cost per hour due to the enactment of mandatory **Paid Sick Leave is \$.015 per hour**.

Below, please find the **monthly** cost increase associated with this mandate:

Area 1 - \$26.00/mo

Area 2 - \$54.60/mo

Area 3 - \$36.40/mo
