1 TWENTY-EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

3 THIS TWENTY-EIGHTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate,
4 as of October 28, 2010 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute
5 order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on
6 November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California
7 corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation
8 ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

9 WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP
10 agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

11 WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could
12 choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

13 WHEREAS, the City desires the WS perform such additional work as
14 provided in the Contract;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions
16 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

17 1. Section 55 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read
18 as follows:

19 "55. EAST VILLAGE 4TH STREET LIGHTING.

20 55.1 Scope of Work. WS shall purchase and install 12-foot-tall
21 contemporary light poles and fixtures; providing foundations; installing necessary conduit,
22 wire and pull boxes; and replacing demolished sidewalks, as more particularly described
23 in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "BB".

24 55.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the East
25 Village 4th Street Lighting, City shall pay to WS upon completion of the services, an
26 amount not to exceed Five Hundred and Three Thousand Twenty-One Dollars
27 (\$503,021.00).

28 55.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and

1 conditions relating to the Street Light System in Lighting contract No. 24289, including all
2 exhibits, shall apply to the East Village 4th Street Lighting”.

3 2. The proposals attached hereto as Exhibit “BB” shall be attached to
4 Lighting Contract No. 24289 as Exhibit “BB” thereto.

5 3. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions
6 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and
7 confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

8 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this document to be duly
9 executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.

RE: 4th Street Decorative Area Lighting Project

Dear Ms. Martin:

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install decorative street lighting on 4th Street from Long Beach Boulevard to Alamitos Avenue in the City of Long Beach.

CLP will purchase and install fifty-two (52) twelve foot Se'Lux Quadrolisk poles (see attached cut sheet) with 70 watt metal halide fixtures, fifty-two (52) new concrete foundations with anchor bolts, the necessary conduit, THHN insulated wire and pull boxes with covers. All demolished sidewalk on 4th Street will be temporarily patched & CLP will restore all demolished sidewalk related to this project. The cost to complete this project is four hundred seventy-nine thousand sixty-eight dollars (\$479,068).

Once CLP has received the letter with your signature indicating the Notice to Proceed, all material will be ordered and all preparation work will commence. The current lead time for the Se'Lux poles that have been chosen for this project is listed at 8-10 weeks.
