A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TERMINATING THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC ENTITY INSURANCE AUTHORITY JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the California State Association of Counties ("CSAC") Excess Insurance Authority ("EIA") and the California Public Entity Insurance Authority ("CPEIA") have merged into one organization, the EIA, and there is no need for the CPEIA to continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, CPEIA members are able to join the EIA as public entity members; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 22 of the CPEIA Joint Powers Agreement ("Agreement") the affirmative vote of the governing bodies of the three-fourth of the members are required to terminate the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, there are no assets or other property to distribute under Article 22 of the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Article 22 of the Agreement it elects to terminate the CPEIA, said termination shall become effective upon the affirmative vote of the governing bodies of three-fourth of the members.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
