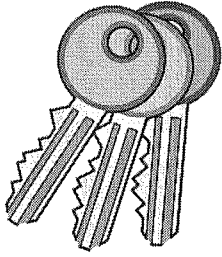


PUBLIC COMMENT HANDOUT - Shirley Broussard
