THIRTY-FOURTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289 24289

THIS THIRTY-FOURTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of January 9, 2014 for reference purposes only, pursuant to minute orders adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meetings held on November 21, 1995 and January 7, 2014, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered the Lighting Contract whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System and perform other work with respect to Other Lights, and simultaneously the parties entered Lease No. 24290 whereby the City leased the street light system to CLP, which Lease contained an obligation by CLP to maintain the system; and

WHEREAS, now the City desires that WS perform other work and maintenance with respect to Other Lights and with respect to newly installed lights in new development in the City, and WS is willing to do so;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in the Lighting Contract and in the Lease, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 61 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
- "61. PINE AVENUE BETWEEN SEASIDE WAY AND ANAHEIM STREET.
- 61.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment for street lighting improvements in conjunction with the Pine Avenue Improvements Project, as more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "II".
- 61.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the Pine Avenue Improvements Project, City shall pay WS for the actual quantity of materials furnished and the actual quantity of work performed in accordance with the Bid Items and Unit

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Prices identified in Exhibit "II"; provided, however, that the total compensation to WS shall not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-One Dollars (\$751,331) for the estimated quantities established in such Exhibit.

- 61.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits, shall apply to the Pine Avenue Improvements Project."
- 2. The proposals attached hereto as Exhibit "II" shall be attached to Lighting Contract No. 24289 as Exhibit "II" thereto.
- Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions 3. contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
