FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34967

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34967 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of May 8, 2019, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on April 9, 2019, by and between ORACLE INVESTIGATIONS GROUP, INC. formerly known as STEVEN BECKMAN INVESTIGATIONS, INC. DBA PAUL CHANCE PRIVATE INVESTIGATIONS, a California corporation ("Contractor"), with a place of business at 13089 Peyton Dr. Suite C, Chino Hills, CA 91709, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with Background Investigation Services ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 34967 ("Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the Agreement amount by Five Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$515,000.00) for a total amount not to exceed Six Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$602,500.00) for the period ending June 1, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 1. of Agreement No. 34967 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "A. Contractor shall furnish specialized services more particularly described in the RFP and Exhibit "A", attached to this Agreement and incorporated by this reference, in accordance with the standards of the profession, and City shall pay for these services in the manner described below, not to exceed Six Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$602,500.00), at the rates or charges shown in Exhibit "B"."
