SAFER CA & The Coalition Summary of Appeal Issues

- All Comments Considered;
 Detailed, Reasoned Written Responses
 - More than what is required by CEQA
- Substantial Evidence: No Significant Impacts
 - Environmental Impact Report is not required

SAFER CASummary of Appeal Issues

- Regulatory Agency-approved Guidance, Methodologies, and Significance Thresholds
 - Adequately disclosed and provided in IS/ND
- Findings Supported by Substantial Evidence
 - Project-related documents identified and referenced in IS/ND;
 Administrative Record
- Mitigation Measures Not Required
 - HDP Special Condition for cleaner construction equipment

The Coalition Summary of Appeal Issues

Air Quality Emissions & Health Risks

Regulatory-approved guidance and methodologies; No significant impacts

Proposed Amendment to SCAQMD Rule 1178

 No CEQA or legal requirement to comply with rules not yet approved or adopted

No Cumulative Impacts

Minor incremental effects—no adverse cumulative impacts under CEQA

COVID-19 Pandemic

No CEQA requirement to consider impacts of pandemic on data and/or project

The Coalition Summary of Appeal Issues

Consultation with California Coastal Commission

 Best available science for sea level rise and flooding; Comments do not pertain to CEQA analysis

Earthquakes, Fires, and Tsunamis

 Project design features and secondary containment would not exacerbate risks; Less than significant

Tank Bottom Sludge Handling

No excessive sludge generated; Less than significant

CEQA Appeal

City Council

Determine whether the Board of Harbor Commissioners' adoption of the Final IS/ND is in compliance with the requirements of CEQA.
