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AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL
SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH
AND THE CITY OF SIGNAL HILL

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 22, 2010 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order of the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held April 20, 2010, and a minute order of the City Council of the City of Signal Hill at its meeting held on June 1, 2010, by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH (hereinafter "Long Beach"), and the CITY OF SIGNAL HILL (hereinafter "Signal Hill").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Signal Hill is a charter city authorized to provide animal control services to its residents, but Signal Hill desires to continue to contract with Long Beach for these services; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Bureau of Animal Care Services is able and willing to provide said services for Signal Hill, and as a charter city, Long Beach is authorized by Section 111 of its Charter to provide the services described herein to Signal Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. TERM. This Agreement shall commence at midnight on July 1, 2010, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2012, unless sooner terminated as provided herein. Signal Hill may extend this Agreement for two (2) consecutive additional periods of two (2) years each by giving notice of its desire to extend to Long Beach thirty (30) days prior to the end of the term or any individual extension period. Upon mutual agreement of the parties to the terms of the extension, the parties shall execute an amendment to this Agreement.

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2. SERVICES.

A. Long Beach shall perform animal control services for Signal Hill, and perform the functions of a Department of Animal Control. In performing these services and functions, Long Beach shall have all of the powers of Signal Hill as if Signal Hill were performing them. Long Beach agrees to provide these services to Signal Hill at the same level that it provides to the residents of Long Beach.

B. Services to be provided to Signal Hill by Long Beach shall include enforcement of the Signal Hill Municipal Code and the laws of the State of California with respect to animal control.

C. In performing the functions of a Department of Animal Control, the Long Beach Bureau of Animal Care Services shall serve as Director of Animal Control for Signal Hill and shall have the following duties:

i. To enforce all Signal Hill ordinances and state laws within Signal Hill city limits with respect to the keeping, harboring and disposition of animals;

ii. To patrol the streets of Signal Hill whenever possible with designated animal control officers to enforce the provisions of the Signal Hill Municipal Code relating to dogs running at large and to respond in a timely manner. Emergency service will be available twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week;

iii. To investigate cruelty to animals complaints brought to its attention;

iv. To pick up and impound on request from an authorized representative of Signal Hill or any resident of Signal Hill any stray dogs within the Signal Hill city limits;

v. To maintain prompt pick-up service for injured animals, and reasonable pick-up services of not more than twenty-four (24) hours for

2 vi. To issue license tags and license receipts;

3 vii. To perform such duties with respect to the control,
4 regulation and protection of animals within Signal Hill as directed from time
5 to time by the Director of Community Development and Services of Signal
6 Hill;

7 viii. To maintain a telephone with listed number which will
8 be answered twenty-four hours every day;

9 ix. To canvass all known households in Signal Hill during
10 the term of this Agreement to insure that all animals required to be licensed
11 are, in fact, licensed.

12 D. Long Beach shall operate a public animal shelter located at
13 7700 East Spring Street, Long Beach, California 90815 to service Signal Hill
14 throughout the term of this Agreement. The animal shelter is currently operated by
15 and for Long Beach for its residents. The operation of the animal shelter will
16 continue at its current level of service or as changed by Long Beach in its
17 discretion.

18 E. Long Beach shall furnish and supply all labor, supervision,
19 equipment and supplies necessary to furnish the level of services required by this
20 Agreement. In the event that supplies, stationery, forms, decals, notices, citations,
21 or any other material must be used that carries the name of Signal Hill, they shall
22 be supplied by Signal Hill at its own cost and expense.

23 3. INDEMNIFICATION. Long Beach agrees to indemnify and hold
24 harmless Signal Hill, its agents, employees and officials against any and all claims,
25 demands, damages, liabilities, costs, suits, or expenses arising out of any act or omission
26 of any officer, agent or employee of Long Beach arising from performance pursuant to
27 this Agreement. Signal Hill agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Long Beach, its
28 agents, employees and officials against any and all claims, demands, damages,

1 liabilities, costs, suits or expenses arising out of any act or omission of any officer or
2 employee of Signal Hill arising from performance pursuant to this Agreement. It is also
3 understood and agreed that, pursuant to Government Code Section 895.4, Long Beach
4 shall indemnify, defend, and hold Signal Hill harmless from any liability imposed for injury
5 (as defined by Government Code Section 810.8) occurring by reason of any acts or
6 omissions on the part of Long Beach under or in connection with any work, authority, or
7 jurisdiction delegated to Long Beach under this Agreement and Signal Hill shall
8 indemnify, defend, and hold Long Beach harmless from any liability imposed for injury (as
9 defined by Government Code Section 810.8) occurring by reason of any acts or
10 omissions on the part of Signal Hill under or in connection with any work, authority, or
11 jurisdiction delegated to Signal Hill under this Agreement.

12 4. FEES.

13 A. For and in consideration of the rendition of services pursuant
14 to this Agreement, Long Beach shall be entitled to and shall retain any and all
15 license fees and other fees authorized by the Signal Hill ordinances relating to
16 animal control. In addition, Long Beach shall be entitled to and shall retain all
17 monies that it collects for the impounding, boarding, and placement of animals. A
18 schedule of license and other fees is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by
19 this reference.

20 B. Signal Hill shall retain all fines imposed by the Signal Hill
21 Municipal Code for violations of animal control ordinances.

22 C. Compensation Schedule.

23 i. Year One (1). In the event and to the extent that the
24 total amount of any and all fees retained by Long Beach does not equal or
25 exceed Sixty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Forty-One Dollars (\$63,441)
26 on June 30 of the first year period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011,
27 then Signal Hill shall pay to Long Beach the difference between the total
28 fees and \$63,441. Payment of the difference shall be made on or before

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July 31 of that same year. In the event and to the extent that the total amount of all license fees retained by Long Beach exceeds \$63,441 on June 30 of that same year, then the excess shall be divided equally between Long Beach and Signal Hill.

ii. Year Two (2). In the event and to the extent that the total amount of any and all fees retained by Long Beach does not equal or exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$64,963) on June 30 of the second year period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, then Signal Hill shall pay to Long Beach the difference between the total fees and \$64,963. Payment of the difference shall be made on or before July 31 of that same year. In the event and to the extent that the total amount of all license fees retained by Long Beach exceeds \$64,963 on June 30 of that same year, then the excess shall be divided equally between Long Beach and Signal Hill.

D. Compensation in the Event of Termination. In the event of termination of this Agreement pursuant to Section 7 or Section 9, Long Beach shall retain fees as compensation for services provided by Long Beach through the effective date of the termination.

i. Year One (1). In the event and to the extent that the total amount of any and all fees retained by Long Beach to the effective date of termination does not equal or exceed Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars (\$5,287) for each month that the Agreement has been in effect until June 30, 2011, then Signal Hill shall pay to Long Beach the difference between the total fees to the effective date of termination and the dollar figure obtained by multiplying \$5,287 times the number of months the Agreement was in effect between July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. A partial month shall be deemed a full month. Payment of the difference shall be made within thirty (30) days of the effective date of termination. Any

1 excess fees shall be paid to Signal Hill.

2 ii. Year Two (2). In the event and to the extent that the
3 total amount of any and all fees retained by Long Beach to the effective
4 date of termination but prior to June 30, 2012 does not equal or exceed
5 Five Thousand Four Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$5,414) for each month
6 that the Agreement has been in effect until June 30, 2012, then Signal Hill
7 shall pay to Long Beach the difference between the total fees to the
8 effective date of termination and the dollar figure obtained by multiplying
9 \$5,414 times the number of months the Agreement was in effect between
10 July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012. A partial month shall be deemed a full
11 month. Payment of the difference shall be made within thirty (30) days of
12 the effective date of termination. Any excess fees shall be paid to Signal
13 Hill.

14 5. ENFORCEMENT. Signal Hill shall cooperate with Long Beach to the
15 fullest extent possible to enforce all Signal Hill ordinances relating to animal control and
16 to enable Long Beach to collect the fees due to Long Beach pursuant to this Agreement.

17 6. KENNELS. Long Beach will maintain its kennels and animal shelters
18 in a humane, sanitary condition. Long Beach will give any notices required by law
19 regarding destruction of animals and use humane methods in their destruction. Long
20 Beach does not knowingly sell animals for medical research.

21 7. ORDINANCES.

22 A. Signal Hill shall adopt or has adopted by reference (in the
23 form of an ordinance) Title 6 of the Long Beach Municipal Code concerning
24 animals to be the animal control ordinance of Signal Hill. Subsequent changes,
25 amendments, additions, deletions, or revisions to the Long Beach Municipal Code
26 regulating animals will have no force or effect on the animal control ordinances of
27 Signal Hill without action by the Signal Hill City Council.

28 B. If the animal control ordinances of Signal Hill are amended

1 during the term of this Agreement, Signal Hill shall, within ten (10) days, give
2 notice to Long Beach of such changes. Long Beach shall notify Signal Hill of any
3 objections to the amendments. If Signal Hill and Long Beach cannot come to a
4 mutually acceptable agreement concerning the amendments within thirty (30) days
5 of the original notice of Signal Hill, Long Beach shall have the right to terminate
6 this Agreement by giving thirty (30) days' notice to Signal Hill. In the event of
7 termination, neither party shall have any further obligation under this Agreement
8 except as provided in Section 4.

9 8. REPORTS.

10 A. Long Beach shall keep and maintain during the term of this
11 Agreement books and records pertaining to the licensing of animals, collection of
12 fees, and impounding of animals. Said books and records shall be available for
13 audit and examination by Signal Hill during normal business hours of Long Beach
14 and on reasonable notice.

15 B. Each month during the term of this Agreement Long Beach
16 will inform the Director of Community Development and Services of Signal Hill of
17 the total dollar amount of license fees collected.

18 C. Long Beach shall maintain a record of all complaints received
19 and furnish the Director of Community Development and Services with a written
20 record of the complaints and the way in which complaints were handled. This
21 information, along with a written report on the operation of the Long Beach Animal
22 Control Program, shall be furnished monthly to the Director of Community
23 Development and Services.

24 9. TERMINATION. Either party may terminate this Agreement by
25 giving to the other party thirty (30) days prior notice, as described in Section 10 below.

26 10. NOTICE. Any notice required or desired to be given by either party
27 shall be in writing and personally delivered or deposited in the U.S. Postal Service, first
28 class, postage prepaid, addressed to Long Beach at 333 West Ocean Boulevard, Long

1 Beach, California 90802 Attention: Bureau of Animal Care Services and to Signal Hill at
2 2175 Cherry Avenue, Signal Hill, California 90806 Attention: Director of Community
3 Development and Services. Notice shall be deemed given on the date deposited in the
4 mail or on the date personal delivery is made, whichever first occurs.

5 11. AMENDMENT. This Agreement shall not be amended, nor any
6 provision or breach hereof waived, except in writing signed by the parties which expressly
7 refers to this Agreement.

8 12. PROHIBITION AGAINST SUBCONTRACTORS OR ASSIGNMENT.
9 Long Beach shall not contract with any entity to perform in whole or in part the work or
10 services required hereunder without the express written approval of Signal Hill. Neither
11 this Agreement nor any interest herein may be assigned or transferred, voluntarily or by
12 operation of law, without the prior written approval of Signal Hill. Any such prohibited
13 assignment or transfer shall be void.

14 13. NON-LIABILITY OF CITY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES. No
15 officer or employee of Signal Hill shall be personally liable to Long Beach, or any
16 successor in interest, in the event of any default or breach by Signal Hill or for any
17 amount which may become due to Long Beach or its successor, or for breach of any
18 obligation of the terms of this Agreement; nor shall any officer or employee of Long
19 Beach be personally liable to Signal Hill, or any successor in interest, in the event of
20 default or breach by Long Beach or for any amount which may become due to Signal Hill
21 or its successor, or for breach of any obligation of the terms of this Agreement.

22 14. CORPORATE AUTHORITY. The person executing this Agreement
23 on behalf of each party warrants that (i) such party is duly organized and existing, (ii) he
24 or she is duly authorized to execute and deliver this Agreement on behalf of such party,
25 (iii) by so executing this Agreement, such party is formally bound to the provisions of this
26 Agreement, and (iv) entering this Agreement does not violate any provision of any other
27 agreement to which a party is bound.


28 15. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement constitutes the entire

1 understanding between the parties and supersedes all other agreements, whether oral or
2 written, with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement.

3 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this document to be duly
4 executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.


