## RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution to authorize designated City officials to execute documents pertaining to financial assistance for costs incurred for declared disasters by the State and Federal Governments. (Citywide)

## DISCUSSION

The State of California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) requires that each city and county seeking aid for a declared disaster provide a Resolution that declares the positions of the officials that are authorized to act as designated City agents. This Resolution must be updated every three years. The City of Long Beach last provided this documentation to CalOES in July 2011.

This matter has been reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Kendra Carney on October 28, 2014 and by Budget Operations Officer Grace Yoon on October 31, 2014.

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this item is requested on December 2, 2014, to ensure the continuity of compliance with State regulations related to state and federal disaster reimbursements.

## FISCAL IMPACT

The submission of this Resolution and CalOES Form 130 will enable the City to recover costs associated with future declared disaster events. There is no local job impact associated with this recommendation.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING  
CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS  
PERTAINING TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COSTS  
INCURRED FOR DECLARED DISASTERS BY THE STATE  
AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, California, desires  
to designate and authorize certain City officials to execute documents pertaining to  
financial assistance for designated emergencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
follows:

Section 1. That the officials employed in the named positions are hereby  
authorized to execute for and in behalf of the City of Long Beach, California, a public  
entity established under the laws of the State of California, applications and other  
documents to be filed in the California Office of Emergency Services and the Federal  
Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of obtaining certain federal financial  
assistance under P. L. 93-288, as amended, by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and  
Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, or state financial assistance under the National  
Disaster Assistance Act, for costs incurred for declared disasters in 1998 and afterwards:

- Assistant City Manager
- Deputy City Manager
- Director of Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Communications
- Director of Financial Management
- City Controller

Section 2. That the City of Long Beach, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, hereby authorizes the above-designated agents of the City to provide to the California Office of Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency the assurances and agreements required for all matters pertaining to state emergency assistance.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
