| 15 | WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend certain provisions and extend the                     |
| 16 | term one (1) additional one-year period;   |
| 17 | NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and                       |
| 18 | conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:                                 |
| 19 | 1. Section 3 of Contract No. 34024 is hereby amended to read as follows:                   |
| 20 | "3. The term of this Contract shall commence on October 1, 2015, and                       |
| 21 | shall terminate at midnight on September 30, 2019 unless sooner terminated as provided     |
| 22 | herein. The City may terminate this Contract by giving thirty (30) days prior notice of    |
| 23 | termination to Contractor."  |
| 24 | 2. Section 6 is added to Contract No. 34024 to read as follows:                            |
| 25 | "6. <u>Ownership of Data</u> . All materials, information and data prepared,               |
| 26 | developed or assembled by Contractor or furnished to Contractor in connection with this    |
| 27 | Agreement, including but not limited to documents, estimates, calculations, studies, maps, |

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1 reports, summaries, drawings, designs, notes, plans, information, material and 2 memorandum ("Data") shall be the exclusive property of City. Data shall be given to City, 3 and City shall have the unrestricted right to use and disclose the Data in any manner and 4 for any purpose without payment of further compensation to Contractor. Copies of Data 5 may be retained by Contractor but Contractor warrants that Data shall not be made 6 available to any person or entity for use without the prior approval of City. This warranty 7 shall survive termination of this Agreement for five (5) years."

3. Section 7 is added to Contract No. 34024 to read as follows:

9 "7. Confidentiality. Contractor shall keep all Data confidential and shall 10 not disclose the Data or use the Data directly or indirectly, other than in the course of 11 performing its services, during the term of this Agreement and for five (5) years following 12 expiration or termination of this Agreement. In addition, Contractor shall keep confidential 13 all information, whether written, oral or visual, obtained by any means whatsoever in the 14 course of performing its services for the same period of time. Contractor shall not disclose 15 any or all of the Data to any third party, or use it for Contractor's own benefit or the benefit 16 of others except for the purpose of this Agreement."

4. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions
contained in Contract No. 34024 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force
and effect.
