Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 11:00 am to 12:30 pm each day of the week.

Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted in the patio area only between the hours of and each day of the week.

The hours of operation shall not exceed 8:00 am to 2:00 am,

The sale of distilled spirits by the bottle for same day or future consumption is prohibited.

<u>C4</u>

There shall be no bar or lounge area upon the licensed premises maintained for the purpose of sales, service or consumption of alcoholic beverages directly to patrons for consumption.

C5

If the premises do not open until 9:00 p.m., full and complete meals must be served wherever the privileges of the license are being exercised.

<u>C6</u>

The premises shall be maintained as a bona fide food restaurant and shall provide a menu containing an assortment of foods normally offered in such restaurants.

<u>C7</u>

The petitioner(s) shall stock and offer for sale a substantial assortment of food and/or merchandise commonly associated with and sold to persons in the community of ______extraction.

<u>C8</u>

Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee(s) shall be removed or painted over within 24hours of being applied.

<u>C9</u>

No "happy hour" type of reduced price alcoholic beverage promotion shall be allowed.

C10

No refrigerated or otherwise chilled _____ shall be sold or maintained on the licensed premises.

<u>C11</u>

The use of any amplifying system or device is prohibited on premises, and the use of any such system or device inside the premises shall not be audible outside the premises.

Sales, delivery and consumption of alcoholic beverages will be restricted to and within the confines of the building portion of the premises and sales or delivery of alcoholic beverages through any pass-out window is prohibited.

<u>C16</u>

The quarterly gross sales of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the gross sales of food during the same period. The licensee shall at all times maintain records which reflect separately the gross sales of food and the gross sales of alcoholic beverages of the licensed business. Said records shall be kept no less frequently than on a quarterly basis and shall be made available to the Department on demand.

C17

There will be no dancing allowed on the premises.

C18

The back door shall be kept closed at all times during the operation of the premises except in cases of emergency. Said door(s) not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door.

C19

The back door(s) shall be kept closed at all times during the operation of the premises except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door.

The rear doors of the premises shall be equipped on the inside with an automatic locking device and shall be closed at all times, and shall not be used as a means of access by patrons to and from the licensed premises. Beer, malt beverages, and wine coolers in containers of 16 oz. or less cannot be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.

There shall be no cups, glasses, or similar receptacles commonly used for the drinking of beverages, sold, furnished, or given away at the petitioner's premises in quantities of less than twenty-four in their original multi-container package.

There shall be no exterior advertising or sign of any kind or type, including advertising directed to the exterior from within, promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages. Interior displays of alcoholic beverages or signs which are clearly visible to the exterior shall constitute a violation of this condition.

C48

No person under the age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages.

C49

No pay phone will be maintained on the interior or exterior of the premises.

C50

All ice shall be sold at or about prevailing prices in the area and in quantities of not less than _____ pounds per sale and shall not be given away free.

C51

Sales and delivery of alcoholic beverages to customers shall be made from behind a counter where a clerk will obtain the product; no self-service of alcoholic beverages will be permitted.

C52

Not more than 10% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages.

C53

The licensee(s) or an employee of the licensee(s) will be present in the patio at all times that alcoholic beverages are being served or consumed.

C54

No person shall be excluded from membership in the club on the basis of race, color, sex, religion, ancestry, disability, marital status or national origin.

C55

Petitioner(s) shall furnish four additional keys and/or passes to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. Such keys or passes shall not be parked or prepared in any manner so as to distinguish the bearer's official capacity. In addition, said keys or passes shall contain random, non-consecutive numbers, various dates of issuance and shall not be identified on any membership lists so as to distinguish the listed member's official capacity.

Petitioner(s) shall police the area under the control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises, as depicted on ABC-253 dated

Off-sale privileges under this license are restricted to sale of malt and vinous beverages containing not more than 3.2 percent of alcohol by weights, and to the sale of beer.

C67 (Use with Private WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 11)

Peace officers, as listed in Section 830.1 of the California Penal Code, and the Director and other persons employed by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for the administration and enforcement of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act are hereby authorized to visit and inspect the proposed premises as outlined in red on form ABC-257, at any time the undersigned is exercising the privileges authorized by the license on such premises.

Subject premises <u>will be solely a business office</u> and no alcoholic beverages will be possessed, stored, or delivered from this location, nor shall there be any direct sales to consumers or retailers from this location.

C68 (Use with Golf WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 14)

Sales of alcoholic beverages from mobile cart are permitted provided there are a substantial assortment of non-alcoholic beverages and snacks offered for sale on the same cart.

Sales of alcoholic beverages from the mobile cart are only permitted at no more than two designated and approved sites on the golf course.

The mobile cart must remain at each designated site for a minimum of four hours.

C69 (Use with Gas or Gas 1 WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Pages 12 & 13)

There is maintained upon the drive-in premises a building or other suitable enclosed structure to be licensed as provided in Section 24040 of the Act, and all sales of alcoholic beverages shall be made from within the licensed enclosure.

No alcoholic beverages shall be sold to any person while such person is in a motor vehicle.

No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any portion of the licensed premises or any portion adjacent thereto which is under the control of the licensee.

The sale and delivery of alcoholic beverages shall be made to persons who are within the licensed premises only and not through a pass-out window, or a slide-out tray to the exterior of the premises.

Alcoholic beverages offered for sale at the licensed premises shall be displayed and available for convenient inspection and purchase within the premises by the general public.

C70 (Use with Wine WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 30)

No wine tasting is to be permitted at this location.

No retail sales of alcoholic beverages to consumed shall be permitted at this location.

C71 (Use with Wine 1 WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 31)

There shall be no importation of beer or malt beverages.

C72 (Use with Wine 2 WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 32)

No retail sales of alcoholic beverages to consumers shall be permitted at this location.

C73 (Use with Club WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 44)

Membership in the club shall be non-discriminatory and will not exclude persons because of race, creed, color, sex, religion or national origin.

The sale, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be made only to or by members of the club and bona fide guests.

The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is prohibited.

_____keys and/or passes, and/or membership cards shall be furnished to the Department. Such keys, passes and/or membership cards shall not be marked or coded in any way such as to distinguish a bearer's official capacity.

C74 (Use with Drive In WHEREAS, See Sample Section E, Page 10)

There is maintained upon the drive-in premises a building or other suitable enclosed structure to be licensed as provided in Section 24040 of the Act, and all sales of alcoholic beverages shall be made from within the licensed enclosure.

No alcoholic beverages shall be sold to any person while such person is in a motor vehicle.

No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any portion of the licensed premises or any portion adjacent there to which is under the control of the licensee.

The sale and delivery of alcoholic beverages shall be made to persons who are within the licensed premises only and not through a pass-out window, or a slide-out tray to the exterior of the premises.

<u>C75</u>

Petitioner shall not share any profits, or pay any percentage or commission to a promoter or any other persons, based upon monies collected as a door charge, cover charge, or any other form of admission charge, including minimum drink orders, or the sale of drinks.

C76

Petitioner(s) shall not require an admission charge or a cover charge, nor shall there be a requirement to purchase a minimum number of drinks.

C77

The licensee shall not sell and/or offer for sale or display any magazine, video or other printed material, which contains pictures depicting:

- Acts or simulated acts of sexual intercourse, masturbation, sodomy, bestiality, oral copulation, flagellation or any sexual acts, which are prohibited by law.
- Any person being touched, caressed or fondled on the breast, buttocks, anus or genitals.
- Scenes where a person displays the vulva or the anus or the genitals.

• Scenes wherein artificial devices or inanimate objects are employed to depict, or drawings are employed to portray, any other prohibited activities described above.

<u>C78</u>

No obstructions shall be attached, fastened or connected to either the partitions or ceiling to separate the booths/dining areas within the interior space of the licensed premises.

C79

Partitions separating the booths/dining areas shall not exceed 52" in height.

C80

VIP/Hospitality alcoves constructed on the premises and depicted on the diagram, shall have the following characteristics:

- (a) No physical obstruction shall be attached, fastened, or connected in any manner to any section of the wall or ceiling at the alcove openings.
- (b) No physical obstruction, including but not limited to planters, partitions or items of décor, shall be placed or attached to any section of the floor at the alcove openings.

<u>C81</u>

The licensee(s) shall not maintain or construct any type of enclosed room intended for use by patrons or customers for any purpose.

C82

The licensee shall not permit "Taxi Dancing" to occur on the licensed premises wherein partners are provided for dancing or social purposes. Social purposes include but are not limited to the soliciting or accepting of any alcoholic beverages from any customers while in the premises.

C83

No employee or agent shall be permitted to accept money or any other thing of value from a customer for the purpose of sitting or otherwise spending time with customers while in the premises, nor shall the licensee(s) provide or permit, or make available either gratuitous or for compensation, male or female persons who act as escorts, or guests of and for the customers.

<u>C84</u>

No employee or agent shall solicit or accept any alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverage from any customer while in the premises.

C85

Petitioner(s) shall make no changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department.

<u>C86</u>

The Petitioner(s) shall post and maintain a professional quality sign facing the premises parking lot(s) that reads as follows:

NO LOITERING, NO LITTERING NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO ARREST

The sign shall be at least two feet square with two inch block lettering. The sign shall be in English and Spanish.

<u>C87</u>

No distilled spirits shall be sold by the bottle.

<u>C88</u>

There shall be no selling of alcoholic beverages for future consumption.

<u>C89</u>

No open bottles of distilled spirits shall be stored in the premises for specific customers.
