"DAY OF ACTION" DEDICATED TO ADVOCATING FOR A
STATE BUDGET THAT SUPPORTS QUALITY PUBLIC
SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, Californians for Justice (CFJ) is a statewide grassroots organization with a local office in Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, CFJ works for justice by organizing and building the power of often marginalized communities, including youth, immigrants, low-income people and communities of color in order to improve their social, economic and political condition; and

WHEREAS, CFJ is currently coordinating a statewide campaign for Quality Education; and

WHEREAS, the CFJ campaign is organizing a "Day of Action" on Thursday, May 15, 2008 in which thousands of students, parents, community advocates, and supporters will converge on Sacramento to advocate that the Governor keep his promise to make 2008 the "Year of Education" by fully funding education;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. To declare May 15th as a "Day of Action" dedicated to advocating for a state budget that supports quality public schools.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
