WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with conducting municipal stormwater runoff and dry weather quality monitoring services; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 31891 whereby Consultant agreed to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term and increase the Agreement amount by an additional \$500,000 for a total not to exceed amount of \$2,200,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in the Agreement and in this Third Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1.A of Agreement No. 31891 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. SCOPE OF WORK OF SERVICES.

A. Consultant shall furnish specialized services more particularly described in Exhibit "A", attached to this Agreement and incorporated by this reference, in accordance with the standards of the profession, and City shall pay for these services in the manner described below, not to exceed Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000), at the rates or charges shown in Exhibit "B"."
