- 2. Appoint to the office any eligible elector if no one has been nominated; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has duly submitted to the City Council a certificate of the fact that only one person has been nominated to be elected for the office of Councilmember, Fourth Council District, and has informed the City Council that it may at a regular or special meeting adopt one of the courses of action indicated above;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Clerk has submitted a certificate to the City Council that at the close of the nomination period on January 15, 2016, only one candidate. Daryl ///
